Welcome to Holy Family Parish

We, the people of Holy Family Parish, in the Diocese of Trenton, are called through Baptism to celebrate the presence of Christ in Word, Sacrament, and Deed. We are called and sent by Christ to live gratefully the life God has given us and to proclaim the good news of Jesus Christ. In the spirit of faith, service, and community, we strive to bring people closer together and closer to God through his son our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Anointing of the Sick

For emergencies call: 732-739-7309. This sacrament is given for those facing serious illness or surgery, and for those of advanced years. If you or a family member is planning to enter the hospital, please see one of the priests following Mass if you would like to receive this sacrament.

Baptism

The Church shares the joy of families in the birth of children and with their parents takes seriously the responsibility of bringing them up in the faith. Parents seeking baptism for their children are to attend a baptismal preparation class held the second Monday of every other month at 7 p.m. Baptisms are held the 2nd and 4th Sunday of the month at 12:30 p.m. by appointment. Parents should be registered members of the parish. Godparents, those who represent the Church in the life of the child, must have received all of their sacraments, and if married, marriage must have been in the Catholic Church. Once sponsors letters are received the Baptism date can be scheduled.

Marriage

This great sacrament of vocation is a very joyous time, but also a time of very serious spiritual preparation. The bishops of New Jersey have adopted a policy to assist in this preparation. Attendance at Engaged Encounter, Pre-Cana, or another approved marriage preparation program; and individual sessions with a priest or deacon are required of all couples. Couples should contact the rectory one year in advance of the intended marriage, and before finalizing other details of the wedding.

R.C.I.A.

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is a learning process introducing adults to the Catholic faith resulting in Baptism, Communion, and Confirmation. For more information, contact the Faith Formation Office.

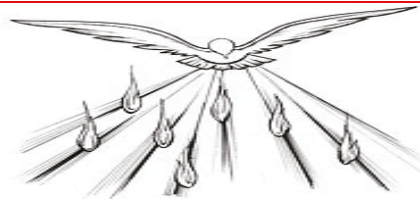

FOURTH AND FIFTH GRADE PARENTS PLEASE REGISTER NO LATER THAN JUNE 22nd to attend the 2023-2024 program.

You may also drop it off to our church **FAITH FORMATION** office (rear of church, first door on walkway #10, large parking lot) see registration times below. **CLOSED FRIDAYS.**

NEW REGISTRANTS

To register NEW STUDENTS in our faith formation program, the following requirements must be met:

1. Family **MUST** first be registered in Holy Family parish, at the rectory.
2. Registration (**in person**) at the Faith Formation office (under the church).
3. **Copy of baptismal certificate for each child (even if baptized at Holy Family).**
4. A non-refundable registration fee as stated below for each child, payable to Holy Family.

EARLY BIRD REGISTRATION FEE: MAY THRU JUNE 30, 2023

1 CHILD \$ 180.00 2 CHILDREN \$ 280.00 3 OR MORE CHILDREN \$ 320.00

REGISTRATION FEE: JULY 1 – AUGUST 31, 2023

1 CHILD \$ 230.00 2 CHILDREN \$ 330.00 3 OR MORE CHILDREN \$ 370.00

5. A referral letter (proof of attendance) is required from a former parish for students transferring to our parish.
6. Third grade through eighth grade must, also, present proof of other sacraments they have made.
7. The normal time to begin faith formation is the year your child begins first grade.

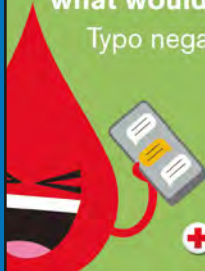
