#### Welcome to Holy Family Parish

We, the people of Holy Family Parish, in the Diocese of Trenton, are called through Baptism to celebrate the presence of Christ in Word, Sacrament, and Deed. We are called and sent by Christ to live gratefully the life God has given us and to proclaim the good news of Jesus Christ. In the spirit of faith, service, and community, we strive to bring people closer together and closer to God through his son our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

#### **Anointing of the Sick**

For emergencies call: 732-739-7309. This sacrament is given for those facing serious illness or surgery, and for those of advanced years. If you or a family member is planning to enter the hospital, please see one of the priests following Mass if you would like to receive this sacrament.

#### **Baptism**

The Church shares the joy of families in the birth of children and with their parents takes seriously the responsibility of bringing them up in the faith. Parents seeking baptism for their children are to attend a baptismal preparation class held the second Monday of every other month at 7 p.m. Baptisms are held the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of the month at 12:30 p.m. by appointment. Parents should be registered members of the parish. Godparents, those who represent the Church in the life of the child, must have received all of their sacraments, and if married, marriage must have been in the Catholic Church. Please choose godparents with these criteria in mind.

#### **Marriage**

This great sacrament of vocation is a very joyous time, but also a time of very serious spiritual preparation. The bishops of New Jersey have adopted a policy to assist in this preparation. Attendance at Engaged Encounter, Pre-Cana, or another approved marriage preparation program; and individual sessions with a priest or deacon are required of all couples. Couples should contact the rectory one year in advance of the intended marriage, and before finalizing other details of the wedding.

#### R.C.I.A.

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is a learning process introducing adults to the Catholic faith resulting in Baptism, Communion, and Confirmation. For more information, contact the Faith Formation Office.
