## **Welcome to Holy Family Parish**

We, the people of Holy Family Parish, in the Diocese of Trenton, are called through Baptism to celebrate the presence of Christ in Word, Sacrament, and Deed. We are called and sent by Christ to live gratefully the life God has given us and to proclaim the good news of Jesus Christ. In the spirit of faith, service, and community, we strive to bring people closer together and closer to God through his son our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

### **Anointing of the Sick**

For emergencies call: 732-739-7309. This sacrament is given for those facing serious illness or surgery, and for those of advanced years. If you or a family member is planning to enter the hospital, please see one of the priests following Mass if you would like to receive this sacrament.

### **Baptism**

The Church shares the joy of families in the birth of children and with their parents takes seriously the responsibility of bringing them up in the faith. Parents seeking baptism for their children are to attend a baptismal preparation class held the second Monday of every other month at 7 p.m. Baptisms are held the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of the month at 12:30 p.m. by appointment. Parents should be registered members of the parish. Godparents, those who represent the Church in the life of the child, must have received all of their sacraments, and if married, marriage must have been in the Catholic Church. Godparents would request a sponsor letter from the parish they are currently registered at. Once sponsors letters are received the Baptism date can be scheduled.

### **Marriage**

This great sacrament of vocation is a very joyous time, but also a time of very serious spiritual preparation. The bishops of New Jersey have adopted a policy to assist in this preparation. Attendance at Engaged Encounter, Pre-Cana, or another approved marriage preparation program; and individual sessions with a priest or deacon are required of all couples. Couples should contact the rectory one year in advance of the intended marriage, and before finalizing other details of the wedding.

### **O.C.I.A.**

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults is a learning process introducing adults to the Catholic faith resulting in Baptism, Communion, and Confirmation. For more information, contact the Faith Formation Office.

## RE-REGISTRATION

Parents with children in our faith formation (religious education) program should have received their re-registration forms **by mail for the 2026-2027** school year.

Please read your letter carefully, make any necessary corrections, **SIGN** and return the form, including the non-refundable registration fee, or promissory note (**call to request**).

SIGNED registrations ONLY will be accepted, for each child. You may return your registration to the Faith Formation Office during office hours (see below) or by mail to: Holy Family Church, Attn: Faith Formation, P.O. Box 56, Keyport, NJ 07735.

## NEW REGISTRANTS

The normal time to begin Faith Formation is the year your child begins first grade.

To register NEW STUDENTS in our faith formation program, the following requirements must be met:

1. Family **MUST** first be registered in Holy Family parish, at the rectory.
2. Registration (**in person**) at the Faith Formation office (Under the church).
3. **Copy of baptismal certificate for each child (even if baptized at Holy Family).**
4. A non-refundable registration fee as stated below for each child:

5. A referral letter (proof of attendance) is required from a former parish for students transferring to our parish.
6. Grades 3 through 8 must also present proof of other sacraments they have made.

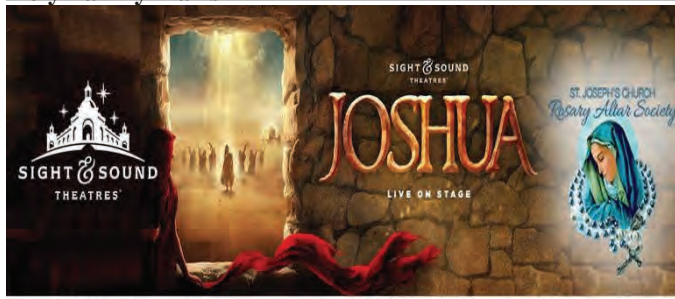

**5 STEPS FOR SAFE DIGGING**

Working on an outdoor project? Always call 8-1-1 first, because you never know what's below. Here are five easy steps for safe digging.

**1. NOTIFY**

Call 8-1-1 or make a request online two to three days before you start.



**2. WAIT**

Wait two to three days for a response to your request. Affected utilities will send a locator to mark any underground utility lines.



**3. CONFIRM**

Confirm that all affected utilities have responded by comparing the markers to the list of utilities the 8-1-1 call center notified.



**4. RESPECT**

Respect the markers provided by the affected utilities. They are your guide for the duration of your project.



**5. DIG CAREFULLY**

If you can't avoid digging near the markers (within 18-24 inches on all sides, depending on state laws), consider moving your project.
