## PASTOR'S PIECE

XXII Sunday of Ordinary Time – September 1, 2024

If to remove the speck in your neighbor's eye you need to remove the plank in your own, it follows that you'll not be much good at flea removal either. Luckily for you, I know fleas. With so many years of personal experience, I took umbrage when my knowledge of these irritants was questioned. As a pastor of a former parish with thirty-seven mission chapels, much of which had dirt floors, I got to know fleas pretty well. I can say that fleas are kind of a barometer of one's faith practice. In addition, they are good correlations to our own personal struggle with sin.

I had a regular parish church in the town of Pedro Santana, the Dominican Republic. I served the town with daily Mass four days a week and one Sunday Mass, but because the people didn't drive, I brought the Mass to many of the towns and villages in a 78 square mile area. So, at best, I would visit 33 chapels once per month. Each village had an instructed catechist and *animador* (cheerleader or enthusiast for the faith). It was their job to gather as many together in the village chapel on the weekends that I wasn't visiting to share the readings of the Mass, offer prayers and sing hymns. If the people hadn't been using their chapel on the Sundays that I wasn't visiting, I could tell. If it was not obvious at first, by the end of Mass, I'd have my suspicions. It wasn't that a little bird told me, but rather little isolated burning sensations up and down my legs. This was because the goats and the pigs loved to escape the sun or seek the shelter in the evening of the four walls and roof of the chapel. They would find ways to squeeze through the planks of the walls or dig underneath the door. The fleas that the animals transported, loved the dirt floor as a place to hide and breed. These pests were simple enough to get rid of, sprinkling some water on the floor and sweeping it with a broom did the trick. But ignoring the problem wasn't an option.

Often times to ignore a flea or think that it was an isolated event is to be confronted soon afterwards with a dozen or more burning bite marks that on an Irish complexion linger for weeks on end. There is only one solution – a full-on clean. One must submit all clothing and bed linens with potential contact to a wash. Shake out and vacuum all areas of possible flea lairs. If one doesn't submit to a full-on clean the problem multiplies exponentially.

The irritation becomes all-consuming to the point of having the itch never far from thought.

This is the status of serious sin. It might seem like a harmless black dot, but its fangs and venom are formidable. It doesn't remain remote harmless and singular. The original holy water clean of Baptism isn't sufficient, but rather the serious medicine of the Lord's remedy found in the Sacrament of Penance. This full-on clean requires a thorough examination of conscience, like counting flea bites when applying Cortizone 10. While we ask the Lord to be absolved, He wants to apply His salve as well. Humbly acknowledging each sin is the Lord's way to not just forgive but heal.

There is one more correlation with evil that a struggle with fleas might illuminate. Those who invite the friends of fleas into their homes, might find that they are the hosts of an infestation. There is only one solution to this situation, the flea bomb. Professionals come to visit the house, and the residents find a place to spend the night or two. As exorcists of our times report, often this requires multiple visits. As a way of avoiding such unpleasantness, we don't knowingly invite unclean entities into our homes.

Outside of applying flea medicine, I'm working a few projects that need your assistance. I'm looking for adult souls interested in learning about the Catholic faith and perhaps preparing for the Sacraments of Initiation. I hope to start an OCIA class (formerly RCIA) October 22 in English at the Mission Office. If there is need for classes in Spanish, now is the time to let me know. Please, call or e-mail the office.

## *El Mensaje del Párroco*

### *XXII Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario – 1 de septiembre, 2024*

Si para sacar la paja del ojo ajeno hay que sacar la viga del propio, se deduce que tampoco se puede sacar muy bien la pulga. Por suerte, yo conozco las pulgas. Con tantos años de experiencia personal, me ofendí cuando se puso en duda mi conocimiento de estos irritantes. Como pastor de una parroquia ante pasada con treinta y siete capillas misioneras, muchas de las cuales tenían suelos de tierra, llegué a conocer bastante bien las pulgas. Puedo decir que las pulgas son una especie de barómetro de la práctica de la fe de uno. Además, son una buena correlación con nuestra propia lucha personal con el pecado.

Yo tenía una parroquia en el pueblo de Pedro Santana, República Dominicana. Yo servía en el pueblo con misas diarias cuatro días a la semana y una misa dominical, pero como la gente no conducía, llevaba la misa a muchas de los pueblos y aldeas en un área de 78 millas cuadradas (200 kilómetros). Así que, en el mejor de los casos, visitaba 33 capillas una vez al mes. Cada pueblo tenía un catequista instruido y un animador. Su trabajo era reunir a la mayor cantidad posible de personas en la capilla del pueblo los fines de semana que yo no visitaba para compartir las lecturas de la misa, ofrecer oraciones y cantar himnos. Si la gente no hubiera estado usando su capilla los domingos que yo no visitaba, me habría dado cuenta. Si no era obvio al principio, al final de la misa, tendría mis sospechas. Nadie me informó, sino más bien pequeñas sensaciones aisladas de ardor que subían y bajaban por mis piernas. Esto se debía a que a las cabras y a los cerdos les encantaba huir del sol o buscar refugio al atardecer en las cuatro paredes y el techo de la capilla. Buscaban formas de colarse entre los tablones de las paredes o cavar debajo de la puerta. Las pulgas que transportaban los animales amaban el suelo de tierra como lugar para esconderse y reproducirse. Estas plagas eran bastante fáciles de eliminar: rociando un poco de agua en el suelo y barriéndolo con una escoba, funcionaba. Pero ignorar el problema no era una opción.

Muchas veces, ignorar una pulga o pensar que fue un evento aislado significa encontrarse poco después con docenas o más de marcas de picaduras que permanecen en el cutis irlandés durante semanas. Solo hay una solución: una limpieza a fondo. Se deben lavar todas las prendas y sábanas que puedan haber estado en contacto. Sacuda y aspire todas las áreas donde puedan haber nidos de

pulgas. Si no se realiza una limpieza a fondo, el problema se multiplica exponencialmente. La irritación se vuelve tan intensa que nunca se piensa en la picazón.

Este es el estado del pecado grave. Puede parecer un punto negro inofensivo, pero sus colmillos y veneno son formidables. No permanece inofensivo ni singular. La limpieza original con agua bendita del Bautismo no es suficiente, sino más bien la medicina seria del remedio del Señor que se encuentra en el Sacramento de la Penitencia. Esta limpieza total requiere un examen de conciencia minucioso, como contar las picaduras de pulgas al aplicar Cortizone 10. Mientras pedimos al Señor que nos absuelva, Él también quiere aplicar Su ungüento. Reconocer humildemente cada pecado es la manera del Señor de no solo perdonar sino sanar.

Existe otra correlación con el mal que la lucha contra las pulgas podría arrojar luz. Quienes invitan a sus casas a los amigos de las pulgas pueden descubrir que son los anfitriones de una plaga. Solo hay una solución para esta situación: la bomba antipulgas. Los profesionales vienen a visitar la casa y los residentes encuentran un lugar donde pasar una o dos noches. Como informan los exorcistas de nuestros tiempos, a menudo esto requiere múltiples visitas. Como forma de evitar este tipo de situaciones desagradables, no invitamos deliberadamente a entidades impuras a nuestras casas.

Además de aplicar remedios contra las pulgas, estoy trabajando en algunos proyectos que necesitan su ayuda. Estoy buscando almas adultas interesadas en aprender sobre el catolicismo y quizás prepararse para los Sacramentos de Iniciación. Espero comenzar una clase de RCIA el 22 de octubre en inglés en la Oficina de la Misión. Si hay necesidad de clases en español, ahora es el momento de hacérmelo saber. También, estoy tratando de organizar las prácticas matrimoniales para las parejas que faltan el sacramento de matrimonio. Por favor, en Virginia no obligatorio de casarse antes de la boda. 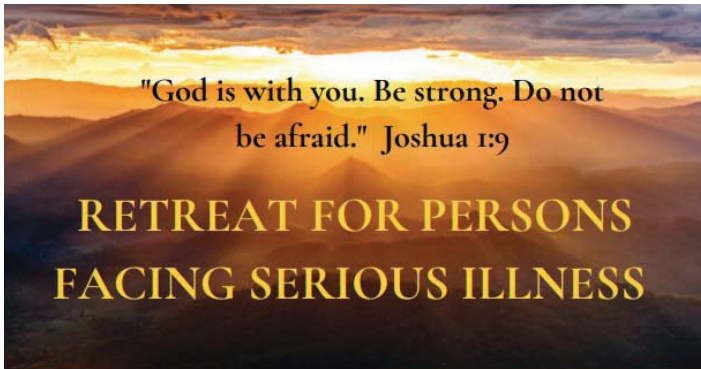
