





PASTOR'S PIECE

Second Sunday of Lent – March 1, 2026

I hope that your Lent is off to a rigorous penitential start. If so, even if not, I've got good news. Tomorrow night (March 2) and Tuesday is a Proper Solemnity for many of you. That is, for you in the physical boundaries of the St. Katharine Drexel Mission, and those who join them, will have a pass from all your Lenten practices, except for the "Alleluia". You still can't say that word during Mass or the Liturgy of the Hours. Nevertheless, we will be singing the Gloria as if it were Sunday during Ordinary Time.

Please, enhance your celebration and ours as we gather at SKD church Sunday night, March 1, at 7:00pm for a Solemn Vesper service. This kicks off our first ever 40 Hour devotion. Fr. Ed Guilloux will Expose the Most Blessed Sacrament, lead our Solemn Vespers and offer a reflection. Then at each hour, members of the parish (at least two at a time) take turns keeping our Eucharist Lord company throughout the hours until St. Katharine's Feast Day Mass, Tuesday, March 3 at 7:00 pm.

In our 40 Hour plus devotion we have some helpful planned breaks. On Monday there is the normally scheduled 8:30 am Mass and at 7:00 pm we have a special guest priest to lead our vesper service and offer his reflection on the Eucharist, Fr. Ricky Malebranche. To ensure that we have round-the-clock adorers of Our Lord exposed on the altar, there is an electronic sign-up list with the bulletin e-mailing.

We are still lacking sufficient adorers. I'm sure that the Holy Spirit will provide. So, please, take the following hours to prayer and see if you can't find a way to make time.

March 3: 12 am, 1 am, 2 am, 3 am, 4 am, **11 am, 12 noon, 1 pm, 4 pm, 5 pm and 6 pm**

If you are concerned about the wee hours and safety, please, know that we have scheduled my brother Knight of Columbus who are signed up to assist us at those hours and keep watch over the church. The emboldened hours are the only ones where nobody is scheduled to be in church.

II Domingo de Cuaresma – 1 de marzo, 2026

Espero que su Cuaresma haya comenzado con un riguroso fervor penitencial. Si es así, o incluso si no, tengo buenas noticias. Mañana por la noche (2 de marzo) y el martes es Solemnidad Propia para muchos de ustedes. Es decir, quienes se encuentren en la Misión de Santa Catalina Drexel, y quienes se unan a ellos, tendrán permiso para una pausa de todos sus rituales cuaresmales, excepto el "Aleluya". Todavía no podrán decir esa palabra durante la Misa ni la Liturgia de las Horas. Sin embargo, cantaremos el Gloria como si fuera domingo durante el Tiempo Ordinario.

Por favor, amenicen su celebración y la nuestra cuando nos reunamos en la iglesia de SKD el domingo 1 de marzo a las 7:00 p.m. para el servicio de Vísperas Solemnes. Esto da inicio a nuestra primera devoción de 40 Horas. El P. Ed Guilloux expondrá el Santísimo Sacramento, dirigirá nuestras Vísperas Solemnes y ofrecerá una reflexión. Luego, a cada hora, los miembros de la parroquia (al menos dos a la vez) se turnan para acompañar a nuestro Señor de la Eucaristía durante todas las horas hasta la Misa del día de la fiesta de Santa Catalina, el martes 3 de marzo a las 7:00 p.m.

En esta devoción de más de cuarenta horas, hay algunos descansos útiles. El lunes se celebra la Misa habitual de las 8:30 a.m. y a las 7:00 p.m. contaremos con un sacerdote invitado especial, el P. Ricky Malebranche, para officiar el servicio de vísperas y ofrecer su reflexión sobre la Eucaristía. Para asegurarnos de tener adoradores de Nuestro Señor expuesto en el altar las 24 horas del día, contamos con una lista de inscripción electrónica y el boletín se envía por correo electrónico.

Aún nos faltan suficientes adoradores. Estoy seguro de que el Espíritu Santo proveerá. Así que, por favor, dediquen las siguientes horas a la oración y vean si pueden encontrar tiempo.
