



all-volunteer, non-profit organization. We were founded in 1970
to provide short-term financial assistance to our less
fortunate neighbors in Middleburg and surrounding areas.

Small but mighty, Middleburg FISH is dedicated to helping
people meet emergencies and immediate needs. From
Monday to Friday, we respond rapidly to requests for help with
rent, utilities – gas, electric, water – as well as medical items
and other problems that need to be addressed right now. Our
goal is to prevent a neighbor's eviction, keep their utilities from
being turned off, help them pay for their life-saving
prescriptions.

The people who answer the phone at FISH – our operators –
are the backbone and the core of the organization. We have a
solid group of operators, but we do need to have some more.

You can be a FISH operator from your cellphone. The FISH
phone number will be forwarded to you as the operator for the
day. When a person calls, you record the details of what they
need and then work with the FISH treasurer to get the person
the necessary assistance.
