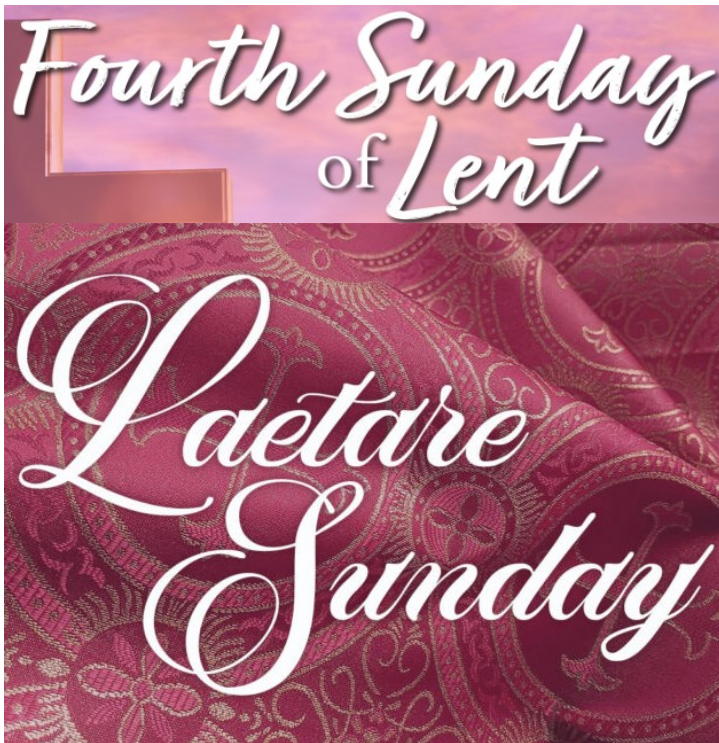

PASTOR'S PIECE

IV Sunday of Lent (Laetare Sunday) – March 15, 2026

Thank you, to all who participated in our SKD 40 Hours devotion. It was a success. I know that it enhanced my Lent. Frankly, my Lent got off to a slow start. I was bogged down with a cold and was in a cold medicine haze for the first week. I was not well disposed to fighting the good fight over creature comforts when I was feeling so poorly.

Perhaps you too feel as if Lent got away from you. This Sunday is Laetare Sunday and marks three more weeks to go. There is no reason not to get into a routine of mortification and extra prayer. Allow me to submit to your meditation the most incisive and pithy explanations of our Lenten disciplines that I've read. It is from St. Peter Chrysologus, a fifth century bishop of Ravenna.

“There are three things, my brethren, by which faith stands firm, devotion remains constant, and virtue endures. They are prayer, fasting and mercy. Prayer knocks at the door, fasting obtains, mercy receives. Prayer, mercy and fasting: these three are one, and they give life to each other.

Fasting is the soul of prayer, mercy is the lifeblood of fasting. Let no one try to separate them; they cannot be separated. If you have only one of them or not all together, you have nothing. So if you pray, fast; if you fast, show mercy; if you want your petition to be heard, hear the petition of others. If you do not close your ear to others you open God's ear to yourself.

When you fast, see the fasting of others. If you want God to know that you are hungry, know that another is hungry. If you hope for mercy, show mercy. If you look for kindness, show kindness. If you want to receive, give. If you ask for yourself what you deny to others, your asking is a mockery.

Let this be the pattern for all men when they practice mercy: show mercy to others in the same way, with the same generosity, with the same promptness, as you want others to show mercy to you.

Therefore, let prayer, mercy and fasting be one single plea to God on our behalf, one speech in our defense, a threefold united prayer in our favor.

Let us use fasting to make up for what we have lost by despising others. Let us offer our souls in sacrifice by means of fasting. There is nothing more pleasing that we can offer to God, as the psalmist said in prophecy: *A sacrifice to God is a broken spirit; God does not despise a bruised and humbled heart.*

Offer your soul to God, make him an oblation of your fasting, so that your soul may be a pure offering, a holy sacrifice, a living victim, remaining your own and at the same time made over to God. Whoever fails to give this to God will not be excused, for if you are to give him yourself you are never without the means of giving.

To make these acceptable, mercy must be added. Fasting bears no fruit unless it is watered by mercy. Fasting dries up when mercy dries up. Mercy is to fasting as rain is to earth. However much you may cultivate your heart, clear the soil of your nature, root out vices, sow virtues, if you do not release the springs of mercy, your fasting will bear no fruit.

When you fast, if your mercy is thin your harvest will be thin; when you fast, what you pour out in mercy overflows into your barn. Therefore, do not lose by saving, but gather in by scattering. Give to the poor, and you give to yourself. You will not be allowed to keep what you have refused to give to others.”

(Liturgy of the Hours, Vol. II, p. 231-232)

Appropriately his name “Chrysologus” is a nickname meaning “Golden-word”.

El Mensaje del Párroco

IV Domingo de Cuaresma (Laetare) – 15 de marzo, 2026

Gracias a todos los que participaron en nuestra devoción de 40 Horas de SKD. Fue un éxito. Sé que mejoró mi Cuaresma. Francamente, mi Cuaresma empezó con lentitud. Estaba resfriado y la primera semana me sentí aturdido por los remedios. No me sentía bien dispuesto a luchar por las comodidades cuando me sentía tan mal.

Quizás ustedes también sientan que la Cuaresma se les ha escapado. Este domingo es Domingo de Laetare y quedan tres semanas más. Todavía no hay razón para no adoptar una rutina de mortificación y oración extra. Permítanme someter a su meditación las explicaciones más incisivas y concisas que he leído sobre nuestras disciplinas cuaresmales. Son de San Pedro Crisólogo, obispo de Rávena del siglo V.

“Tres cosas hay, hermanos, por las que se mantiene la fe, se conserva firme la devoción, persevera la virtud. Estas tres cosas son la oración, el ayuno y la misericordia. Lo que pide la oración lo alcanza el ayuno y lo recibe la misericordia. Oración, misericordia y ayuno: tres cosas que son una sola, que se vivifica una o a otra.

El ayuno es el alma de la oración, la misericordia es lo que da vida al ayuno. Nadie intente separar estas cosas, pues son inseparables. El que solo practica una de ellas, o no las practica simultáneamente, es como si nada hiciese. Por tanto, el que ora que ayune también, el que ayuna que practique asimismo la misericordia. Quien desea ser escuchado en sus oraciones que escuche él también a quien le pide, pues el que no cierra sus oídos a las peticiones del que le suplica abre los de Dios a sus propias peticiones.

El que ayuna que procure entender el sentido del ayuno: que se haga sensible al hambre de los demás, si quiere que Dios sea sensible a la suya; si espera alcanzar misericordia, que él también la tenga; si espera piedad, que él también la practique; si espera obtener favores de Dios, que él también sea dadivoso. Es un mal solicitante el que espera obtener para sí lo que él niega a los demás.

Hombre, sé para ti mismo la medida de la misericordia; de este modo, alcanzarás misericordia del modo que quieras, en la medida que quieras, con la presteza que quieras; tan sólo es necesario que tú te compadezcas de los demás con la misma presteza y del mismo modo.

Hagamos, por consiguiente, que la oración, la misericordia y el ayuno sean los tres juntos nuestro patrocinio ante Dios, lo tres junto nuestra defensa, los tres junto nuestra oración bajo tres formas distinta.

Reconquistemos con nuestro ayuno lo que perdimos por no saberlo apreciar; inmoemos con el ayuno nuestras almas, y que éste es el mejor sacrificio que podemos ofrecer a Dios, como atestigua el salmo: *Mi sacrificio es un espíritu quebrantado: un corazón quebrantado y humillado tu no lo desprecias.*

Hombre, ofrece tu alma a Dios, ofrécele el sacrificio del ayuno, para que sea una ofrenda pura, un sacrificio santo, una víctima viva que, sin salirse de ti mismo, sea ofrecida a Dios. No tiene excusa el que niega esto a Dios y a que está en manos de cualquiera el ofrecerse a sí mismo.

Mas, para que esto sea acepto a Dios, al ayuno debe acompañar la misericordia; el ayuno no da fruto si no es regado por la misericordia, se seca sin este riego: lo que es la lluvia para la tierra, esto es la misericordia para el ayuno. Por más que cultive su corazón, limpie su carne, arranque sus malas costumbres, siempre las virtudes, si no abre las corrientes de la misericordia, ningún fruto recogerá el que ayuna.

Tú que ayunas, sabe que tu campo, si está en ayunas de misericordia, ayuna él también; en cambio, la liberalidad de tu misericordia redundará en abundancia para tus graneros. Mira, por tanto, que no salgas perdiendo, por querer guarda para ti, antes procura recolectar a largo plazo; a dar al pobre das a ti mismo, y lo que no dejas para los demás no lo disfrutarás tú luego.” (Liturgia de las Horas, Vol. II, p.207-208)

Apropiadamente su “Crisólogo” es un apodo que significa “Palabra de oro”.

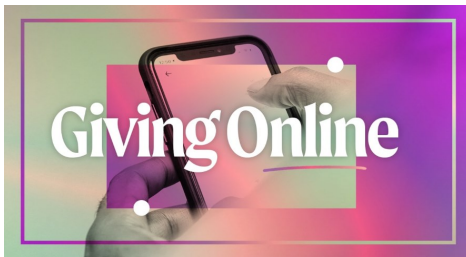

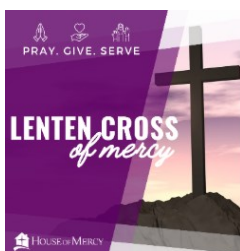
