PASTOR'S PIECE

IV Sunday of Easter – April 26, 2026

The Lord is risen! Alleluia!

He is risen, indeed! Alleluia! Alleluia!

I can imagine that if my parents had sat my brothers and sister down in our youth as a family and asked, how should we be managing things? Or, better yet, what can we do to serve you better? The responses would have been focused on increased allowances, vacations to Disney World, barely-there curfews, the latest Atari games for birthdays or Christmas... This is probably why it never even occurred to my parents to take such a course change in their parenting, but even more likely, it just is outside the nature of parenting. It isn't how God ordered family life.

The Church mirrors God-created family life with God the Father, our Brother and Lord, Jesus the Christ, and the head of the family on earth, the Pope or *Papa*. Nevertheless, there are elements that speak of earthly models of governing. The Pope is a monarch. He is elected. Bishops gather in councils and have national conferences. The bishop and your pastor are answerable to our finance committees. And so, in the spirit of good stewardship and openness to the Holy Spirit abiding in all the faithful, the Church is searching for a way to give a channel of communication to all the members of the Mystical Body of Christ.

Pope Francis' answer was synodality. He called together representatives from all over the Church to gather at the parochial, diocesan and global level. I don't remember how many synods there were, but I vaguely remember that they weren't yet complete. So, our new Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV is taking up where his predecessor left off. He too is calling for synodal meetings at the various levels.

I bring this to your attention because our apostolic representative, Bishop Burbidge, sincerely wants you to contribute to this process. He has asked that I provide ten parishioners from each church to attend the Synodal Ecclesial Assembly at Holy Trinity Parish, May 16.

For those who are interested in contributing to the synodal process, please, call the proper office of SSM or SKD depending on where you are registered and give the secretary your name. She will give you the details. When we have ten names for each church that will be it. First come first served, but remember, it isn't about curfews and allowances. At least, I don't think so.

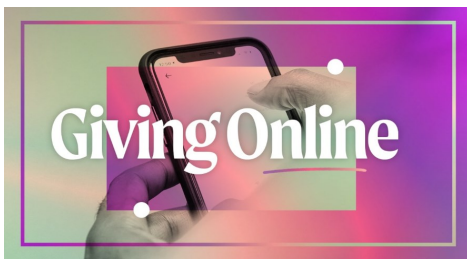

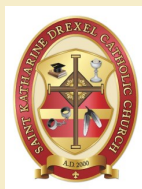
