Women who take the birth control pill have a smaller hypothalamus than those who do not, and report anger and depression more often, report researchers. "The mean difference in volume of hypothalamus was about 6%, about 60 μ L," said Michael Lipton, MD, PhD, from the Albert Einstein College of Medicine in Bronx, New York. "It was very surprising to us that oral contraceptive use would have this degree of effect on the actual structure of a central part of the brain," he told Medscape Medical News. The study did not show that oral contraceptives

cause the difference, he pointed out, "but it is a very strong association."

Limits to celebrating diversity -- Archaeologists in Peru have unearthed what is believed to be the largest single mass child sacrifice in history. The bodies of 227 victims, aged between five and 14, were found near the coastal town of Huanchaco, north of Peru's capital Lima. The children were believed to have been sacrificed over 500 years ago. The discovery comes barely a year after 200 child victims of human sacrifice were found at two other sites in the country. Archaeologists told AFP news agency that some of the bodies in this latest collection still had hair and skin when they were dug up. The children show signs of being killed during wet weather, and were buried facing the sea, meaning they were probably sacrificed to appease the Chimú's gods.

It can be clearly seen in the life of Svetlana Alliluyeva. From childhood, she was Svetlana Stalina, the only daughter of Soviet dictator Josef Stalin. Later, she took her mother's name, and later still, while living in the United States and upon marrying an American, she became Lana Peters. Born in 1926, she grew up in an atmosphere where God was never mentioned. Her father ruled over a Communist Party and government that did its best to minimize religion's role in people's lives—or use it to advance communist ideology. In the long run, however, that temporal power was not stronger than the example of Stalin's Georgian mother—Svetlana's paternal grandmother.

Music Corner (by Jerry Kavinski)

Today's communion motet is by William Byrd (c. 1540 - 1643). Originally published in 1589, *Ne Irascaris, Domine/Civitas Sancti Tui* (parts I and II, respectively) is a true gem in the sacred music canon, with lush harmonies and plaintive melodic imitation. The text of the second part, *Civitas Sancti Tui*, translates as follows:

Your holy city has become a wilderness.
Zion has become a wilderness,
Jerusalem has been made desolate.

Certainly a fitting Lenten text, but also one that has been said to have held special meaning for the composer, a Catholic living in England during the Protestant Reformation. The story goes that Bryd used this text as a lacrimose metaphor as the Eucharist was being indefinitely removed from the tabernacle and thus, was leaving the church desolate. The final line of the text, Jerusalem *desolata est*, paints this somber image in poetry and music.
