"Embracing the Struggle"

The child is born in love with the struggle. Picture a twoyear-old attempting to put on socks by himself. This can be a monumental task for a small child, but do we embrace this struggle or swoop in to help? We may not feel comfortable seeing our child struggle, but it is a necessary part of development.

Maria Montessori said "Any unnecessary aid given to the child arrests his development." These are strong and important words for adults. The "struggle" is a crucial element for life-long learning. Persevering through challenges and staying on task gives the child a sense of accomplishment and self-confidence.

Perhaps we need to reflect on our own attitude when our children struggle, or when they are uncomfortable with tasks that are not always enjoyable. Do we take over and "rescue" our child, just to "keep the peace"? Naturally, parents want to protect their children from discomfort, but these moments are crucial and will affect the way the child views the world into adulthood. We should give just enough help and support so that the child can accomplish the task for himself. Let's not rob our children of the joy of accomplishment by embracing their struggle.


