A Woman's Choice March Diaper Drive - the pro-life center in Herndon, will be collecting diaper donations after all Masses this weekend. Disposable diapers are not an allowable expense for federal assistance through programs such as the Women, Infant, and Children's Program (WIC) or the Supplemental Nutritional Assistance Program (SNAP). A single mother, working fulltime and earning the federal minimum wage will spend over 6% of her gross salary on diapers for just one child. The need for diapers is current and on-going. According to data from the NDBN Diaper Check 2023: Diaper Insecurity Among U.S. Children and Families: 1 in 2 U.S. families cannot afford enough diapers to keep their infant or child clean, dry, and healthy. These babies are prone to rashes and urinary tract infections and more trips to the doctor. The data also shows that 3 in 5 parents miss school or work because they cannot afford the diapers required to leave their baby in childcare or preschool. Like food, clean diapers are an essential

need of every baby and toddler. *Please place your donations in the Pack and Play in the Narthex this weekend.* All sizes are needed, but especially sizes 1 and 5. God bless you for your generosity.
