St. William of York Reredos Renovation Project

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ-

As many of you have heard by now, we are moving forward on a redesign of the sanctuary space of our beloved church. In keeping with our ongoing enhancement efforts, the new design will create the reverence and sophistication befitting the space in which “the most beautiful thing this side of heaven” reoccurs for us every day at St. William of York.



The rendering you see above is the result of nearly a year of coordination with designers, architects and ultimately the Arlington Diocese Office of Divine Worship. Official approval from Bishop Burbidge arrived just over a week ago, and I am delighted to begin the next phase of this project.

We will commence an official fundraising campaign shortly, but I wanted to provide you with a preliminary sense of the immediate next steps. In an effort to ensure responsible stewardship of the faithful contributions of our beloved parishioners, I have assured the Bishop that we will refrain from any building and installation until we have raised half of the overall cost of the project. I am happy to report that we are well on our way. Prior to an official campaign and through only word of mouth, we are already over \$30,000 in what might be called “seed financing.” Thank you for your heartfelt support. This is truly a testament to the overwhelming support for this project.

I would like to begin the construction and installation of this beautiful reredos and sanctuary renovation this summer so as to be fully complete before the Advent season. (What a true blessing it will be to celebrate our Advent and Christmas Masses in such a beautiful setting.) With that in mind, there are many who have asked how to support this exciting project. Details on the official fundraising campaign will be forthcoming but until that time, feel free to **simply annotate on your normal donations “Reredos Project – Donation”** and the support will help us achieve our 50% goal as soon as possible.

As always, I am humbled by your ongoing support for all we are doing at St. William of York, and I look forward to turning this beautiful dream into a reality that so many will be blessed to enjoy for generations to come.


