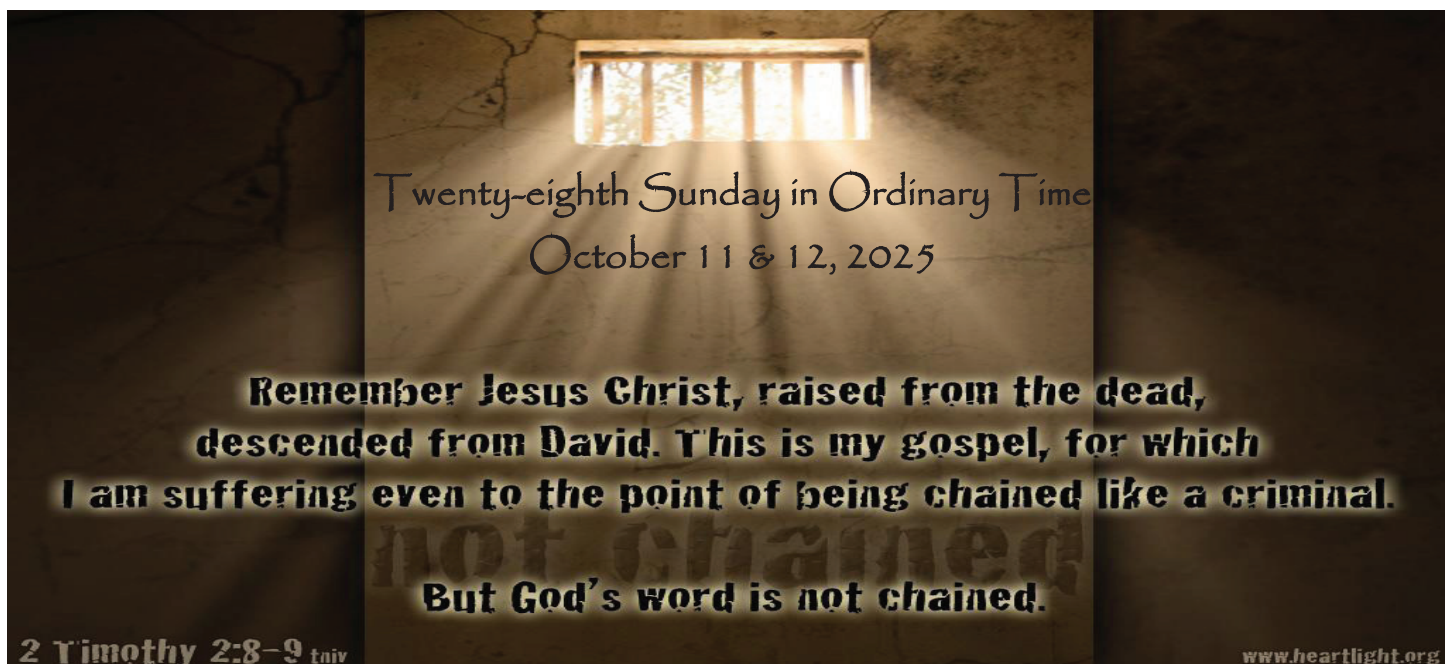

From today's Gospel reading:

When Jesus saw the lepers, he said,
 "Go show yourselves to the priests."
 As they were going they were cleansed."

Reflection:

The lepers' cure came as they traveled. Perhaps we too realize that the healings we need, the physical, emotional and spiritual ones, don't happen all at once, but occur as we travel, step by step, through life. Isn't that the way most of us come to wholeness – step by step – with the help of trusted family, friends, counselors, teachers, etc. who help us experience cleansing and renewal? Do we "realize," as the cured leper did, that it is Jesus who is the source of our healing?

So, we ask ourselves:

- Can I name some of the healings that have happened in my life through faith?
- How have I returned thanks to God for those healings?

Thanks to all parishioners who donated to our annual September drive to support Catholic Charities St. Lucy Project, which assists numerous families who face food insecurity in the Diocese. Parishioners showed great generosity by donating nearly 3,000 pounds of food as well as \$610 in cash and checks. Also, a big thanks to the 11:00 Mass ushers and Spanish Mass community after the 1:30 Mass for helping move the large number of heavy bags of food from the bride's room into the St. Lucy van on Sunday, September 28th. Spotlight on Outreach

St. Ann Blood Drive Twice a year, approximately every June/July and November/December, on Sundays from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm, St. Ann holds a blood drive in Room 105, in the lower level of the church. Our blood drive is sponsored by INOVA Blood Donor Services. This ministry has been active for over 20 years. Each year an average of 30-35 St. Ann parishioners, per blood drive, have participated in this life saving event for use in our Northern Virginia Community. Here are some facts about our blood donations:

- Blood used for transfusions in hospitals only comes from generous volunteer blood donors.
- If all blood donors donated just one more time per year, blood shortages would be rare.
- There is no substitute for human blood. It can only come from a volunteer blood donor.
- Thirty-eight percent of the U.S. population is eligible to donate, but less than 5% actually do.
- One in seven people entering the hospital need blood.
- The average adult has 10 pints of blood in their body, roughly 1 pint is given during a donation.
- You can burn up to 500 calories with a single blood donation

Volunteers: 16 and up, at least 110 pounds and in good health.

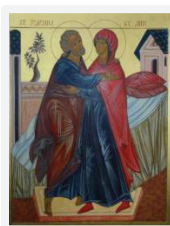

De la lectura del Evangelio de hoy:

Cuando Jesús vio a los leprosos, les dijo: «Id a mostraros a los sacerdotes». Y mientras iban, quedaron limpios.

Reflexión:

La curación de los leprosos se produjo mientras caminaban. El Papa León ha pedido a todos los católicos que recen el rosario todos los días de octubre por la paz.

Aunque solo sea una decena, rezar el rosario en familia —¡lo cual se puede hacer en el coche de camino a la iglesia o al colegio!— Es una forma estupenda de enseñar a tus hijos las oraciones básicas de la fe católica.

**Sacramentos de iniciación en Santa Ana**

Como recordatorio, la Iglesia pide que los sacramentos de iniciación se celebren en determinados momentos de la vida. El bautismo debe realizarse lo antes posible después del nacimiento. La primera comunión sigue a la primera penitencia y se celebra en segundo grado en la mayoría de las diócesis estadounidenses que no confieren primero la confirmación. En Estados Unidos, la edad para la Confirmación la decide el obispo diocesano, con la condición de que se celebre entre los 7 y los 16 años. En St. Ann, se celebra en 9.º grado. Si alguien de su familia necesita alguno de estos sacramentos, póngase en contacto con Amy para que le ayude con los preparativos.

Aproximadamente dos veces al año, en junio/julio y noviembre/diciembre, los domingos

de 8:00 a. m. a 12:00 p.m. Santa Ana organiza una campaña de donación de sangre en la sala 105, en la planta baja de la iglesia.

Nuestra campaña de donación de sangre está patrocinada por INOVA Blood Donor Services. Este ministerio lleva más de 20 años en activo. Cada año, una media de entre 30 y 35 feligreses de St. Ann, por campaña de donación de sangre, han participado en este evento que salva vidas para su uso en nuestra comunidad del norte de Virginia. A continuación se presentan algunos datos sobre nuestras donaciones de sangre:

- La sangre que se utiliza para las transfusiones en los hospitales solo proviene de generosos donantes voluntarios.
- Si todos los donantes de sangre donaran solo una vez al año, la escasez de sangre sería poco frecuente.
- No hay sustituto para la sangre humana. Solo puede provenir de un donante voluntario.
- El 38 % de la población estadounidense es apta para donar, pero menos del 5 % lo hace realmente.
- Una de cada siete personas que ingresan en el hospital necesita sangre.
- Un adulto medio tiene 4,7 litros de sangre en su cuerpo, y durante una donación se extraen aproximadamente 0,5 litros.
- Se pueden quemar hasta 500 calorías con una sola donación de sangre.

Voluntarios: mayores de 16 años, con un peso mínimo de 50 kg y en buen estado de salud.
