

From today's Gospel reading:

"As they were coming down from the mountain, Jesus charged them, "Do not tell the vision to anyone until the Son of Man has been raised from the dead."

Reflection:

Jesus teaches patience. Let the experience sink in. Let it be tested by daily fidelity. The deepest witness is not excited talk, but steady discipleship shaped by the cross and illuminated by hope.

So, we ask ourselves:

- What "mountain moments" have strengthened my faith, and how have they shaped my daily life afterward?
- Do I seek glory without accepting the cross that gives it meaning?
- How is Christ asking me to live quiet, patient faith right now, even without dramatic experiences?

HOLY COMMUNION UNDER BOTH KINDS

On Saturday/Sunday Masses,
5.30 pm, 9.00 am & 11.00 am

Holy Communion under both kinds is the Catholic and Christian practice of receiving both the consecrated bread (Body of Christ) and the consecrated wine (Blood of Christ) during the Eucharist.

While receiving only one form is considered valid because the entire Christ is present in each, receiving under both kinds provides a fuller sign of the Eucharistic meal, symbolizing the new covenant and the relationship with Christ more clearly. This practice was the norm for centuries and is still common in Eastern traditions, though in the Latin Rite of the Catholic Church, receiving under the form of bread alone is the more frequent practice, especially for the laity.

Catholic Practice:

Priest's Obligation: In the Latin Rite, the priest celebrant is obligated to receive the Eucharist under both kinds.

Laity's Choice: The laity are not bound to receive under both kinds, though it is encouraged when circumstances permit.

Full Presence in Each Form: The Church teaches that the entire Christ—His Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity—is present in both the consecrated bread & the consecrated wine.

Receiving only one species does not deprive the communicant of any grace.






Spotlight on Outreach



St. Ann Hospital Ministry. Did you know that volunteers from St. Ann administer Holy Communion to sick Catholics at the Virginian Hospital Center (VHC)? Members of the Hospital Ministry offer Communion, as well as prayer and comfort each weekday. The ministry dates from the early days of the parish but became more structured in 2006 to meet the growing needs at VHC. By 2017, it had more than 35 volunteers covering every day of the week. Volunteer numbers were greatly reduced during the pandemic but have gradually increased in the last two years to about 20 now. At times of illness or injury, the Eucharist can be of great importance and comfort. In addition, the St. Ann volunteers receive many expressions of gratitude from patients, often quite moving and encouraging. The ministry's goal is to assure volunteers are present at the hospital daily, including weekends, to bring the Holy Communion to the Catholic patients who desire such a visit and spiritual comfort. New volunteers are always welcome. The time commitment can range from weekly to monthly, depending on what the volunteer is able to give. Visits range from 2 to 3 1/2 hours.
