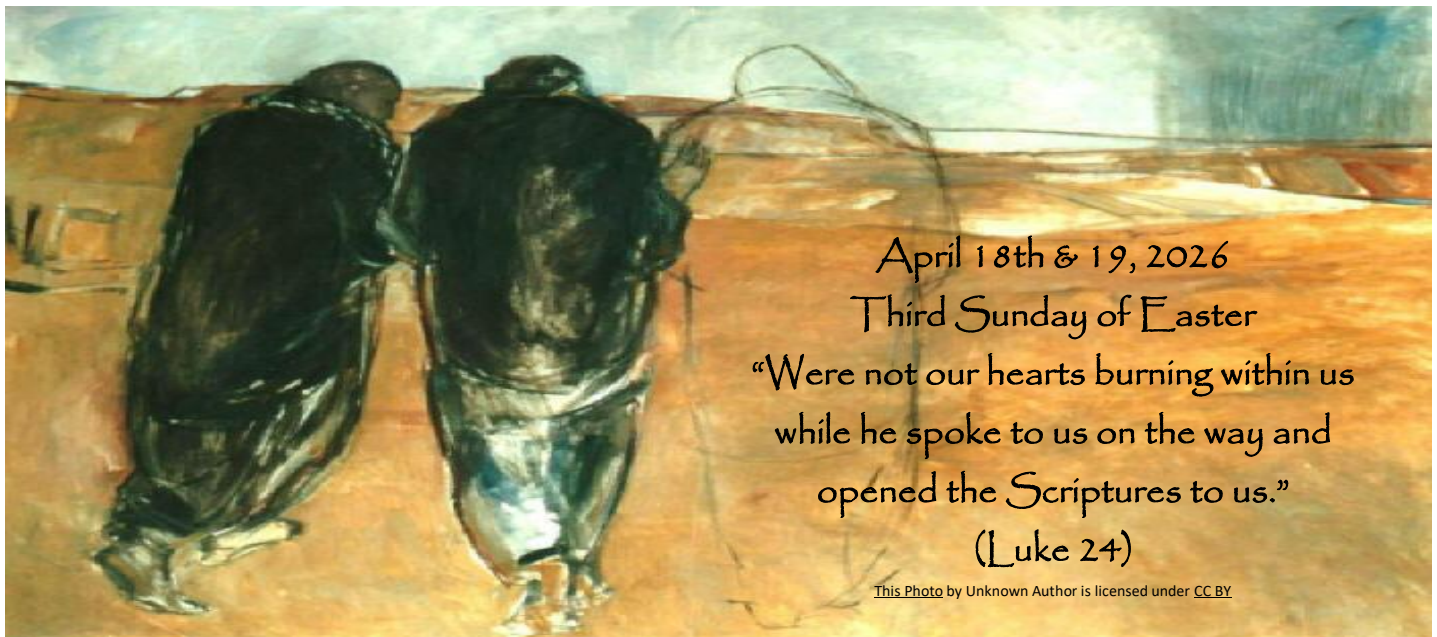

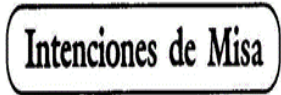

FROM TODAY'S GOSPEL

They said to him,

"The things that happened to Jesus the Nazarene,
who was a prophet mighty in deed and word
before God and all the people,

how our chief priests and rulers both handed him over
to a sentence of death and crucified him.
But we were hoping that he would be the one to redeem
Israel."

REFLECTION:

Hope is the virtue that enables us to dream big dreams and work to put them into reality. But we often need our hopes nourished, because if what we hope for is important----peace, care for the elderly, an end to the death penalty, a rejuvenated and healed church, good liturgy and preaching in our parish, housing for the elderly, an end to domestic violence, equality of women and gays in our churches and communities, fair treatment for immigrants, and so much more----then we will need encouragement, perseverance, passion, clear thinking and the support of a believing and hoping community. We need the Word of God, the Eucharist and a faith community that shares our dreams and gives us hope.

AND SO, WE ASK OURSELVES:

- When I am discouraged, who gives me hope?
- Who are the people in the world who kindle hope in me and challenge me to persevere in my good works?

As we prepare to conclude our faith formation classes for this year in May, we hope that parents of ALL parish children who will be in public school next year from Kindergarten-eighth grade have contacted Amy with their choice of classes. If you have not done this yet, **please do so this week**. We are also happy to accommodate friends, family, and neighbors who are not parishioners at St. Ann, as long as we have sufficient catechists and space in the classroom.

Participation in faith formation each year from Kindergarten through eighth grade inclusive is expected, but we will help families who have missed grades catch their children up.

As a reminder, this is when the sacraments of initiation are conferred on children. Please do not deprive your children of the graces of the sacraments they can receive by delaying them, and remember that intellectual knowledge of the tenets of the faith is far less important than lived experience of the faith being practiced at home!

Baptism is to be celebrated as soon as possible after birth. **First Penance and First Communion** are to be celebrated around the age of reason (age 7).

Confirmation is celebrated in the Diocese of Arlington in 8th or 9th grade; at St. Ann, the immediate preparation is in 8th grade, with reception of the sacrament at the start of 9th grade.

If you are an adult who missed one or more of these sacraments (or you have a child who is late in receiving them), please reach out to Amy **this week** so we can begin to work with you over this summer.

DEL EVANGELIO DE HOY

Ahora que nos preparamos para concluir en mayo nuestras clases de formación en la fe de este año, esperamos que los padres de **TODOS** los niños de la parroquia que el próximo año cursarán estudios en escuelas públicas, desde el jardín de niños hasta el octavo grado, se hayan puesto en contacto con Amy para comunicarle su elección de clases. **Si aún no lo han hecho, por favor háganlo esta semana.** También nos complace acoger a amigos, familiares y vecinos que no sean feligreses de Santa Ana, siempre y cuando contemos con suficientes catequistas y espacio en el aula.

Se espera la participación en la formación en la fe cada año desde el jardín de infantes hasta el octavo grado inclusive, pero ayudaremos a las familias que se hayan perdido algún grado a que sus hijos se pongan al día.

Como recordatorio, este es el momento en que se confieren los sacramentos de iniciación a los niños. Por favor, no priven a sus hijos de las gracias de los sacramentos que pueden recibir al retrasarlos, y recuerden que el conocimiento intelectual de los principios de la fe es mucho menos importante que la experiencia vivida de la fe que se practica en casa.

El bautismo debe celebrarse lo antes posible después del nacimiento.

La Primera Penitencia y la Primera Comuni3n deben celebrarse alrededor de la edad de la razón (7 años).


