PARISH SURVEY

Columbarium & Memorial Garden

For more than twenty years, the former convent (built in 1951) has stood vacant due to significant deterioration. Professional assessments indicate that the building is no longer habitable and would require substantial investment—estimated at over \$4 million for school use or at least \$2 million for a limited rectory.

After prayerful consideration, parish leadership is exploring an alternative: **Replacing the old convent & transforming the site into a parish columbarium & memorial garden.** This would create a sacred place for cremated remains (cremains) and Christian remembrance—rooted in the Catholic teaching—where families can pray for their loved ones and remain connected to parish life.

Preliminary analysis suggests that this type of project could potentially be developed in phases, self-funded gradually over time, without long-term debt, and that net proceeds approaching the cost to renovate the convent would provide **funds** for re-investment in our school buildings (now approaching 60-75 years old) -- used by both the School and Faith Formation classes.

With the encouragement of our Parish Pastoral Council, Finance Council, and school leadership, we have received permission from Bishop Burbidge to study this possibility further. Moving forward, we will follow a detailed process that involves re-evaluation of this project at several critical stages.

A **parish-wide survey** is available starting on May 31, as part of our feasibility studies. Your feedback—questions, concerns and support—will help guide our discernment and the best path forward.

Please keep this effort in your prayers as we seek to steward our parish resources faithfully.

ha guiado todo vuestro camino por el desierto...».

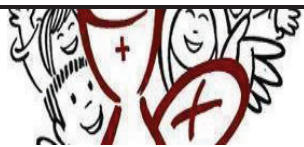
Reflexión:

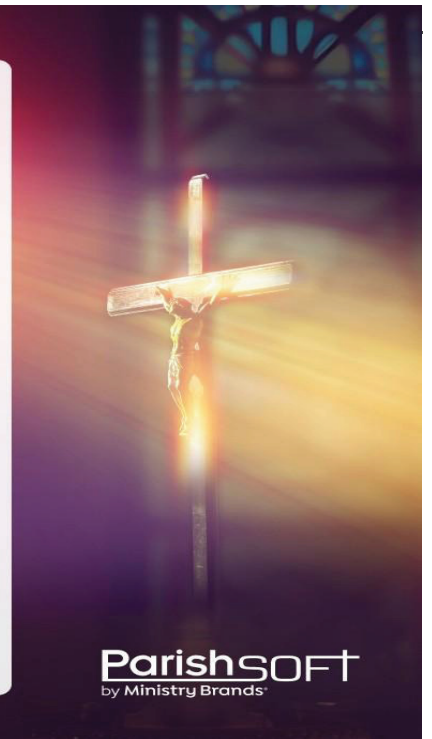

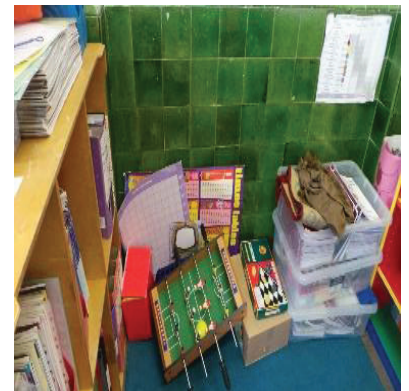
El verano es un buen momento para que nos pongamos manos a la obra con la «limpieza general» aquí en Santa Ana.

Se solicita la opinión de la parroquia:
Columbario y jardín conmemorativo

Durante más de veinte años, el antiguo convento (construido en 1951) ha permanecido desocupado debido a su grave deterioro. Las evaluaciones profesionales indican que el edificio ya no es habitable y que requeriría una inversión considerable: se estima que más de 4 millones de dólares para uso escolar o al menos 2 millones de dólares para una rectoría de uso limitado. Tras una reflexiva consideración, los líderes de la parroquia están explorando una alternativa: reemplazar el antiguo convento y transformar el sitio en un columbario parroquial y un jardín conmemorativo. Esto crearía un lugar sagrado para las cenizas y el recuerdo cristiano — arraigado en la enseñanza católica— donde las familias puedan orar por sus seres queridos y mantenerse conectadas con la vida parroquial.

Un análisis preliminar sugiere que este tipo de proyecto podría desarrollarse en fases, autofinanciándose gradualmente con el tiempo, sin deuda a largo plazo, y que los ingresos netos, cercanos al costo de renovar el convento, proporcionarían fondos para reinvertir en nuestros edificios escolares (que ahora tienen entre 60 y 75 años de antigüedad), utilizados tanto por la escuela como por las clases de formación en la fe.

Con el apoyo de nuestro Consejo Pastoral Parroquial, el Consejo de Finanzas y la dirección de la escuela, hemos recibido permiso del obispo Burbidge para estudiar esta posibilidad más a fondo. De cara al futuro, seguiremos un proceso detallado que implica la reevaluación de este proyecto en varias etapas críticas.

Desde el 31 de mayo está disponible una encuesta para toda la parroquia, como parte de nuestros estudios de viabilidad.

Sus comentarios —preguntas, inquietudes y muestras de apoyo— nos ayudarán a orientar nuestro discernimiento y a encontrar el mejor camino a seguir.

Les pedimos que incluyan esta iniciativa en sus oraciones, mientras procuramos administrar fielmente los recursos de nuestra parroquia.
