On this weekend, we give thanks to all our parish catechetical volunteers—whether they serve with the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA), the Children's Liturgy of the Word, or in our Spanish and English faith formation classes.

From today's Gospel reading:

What if I wish to give this last one the same as you? Or am I not free to do as I wish with my own money. Are you envious because I am generous? "Thus, the last will be first, and the first will be last."

Reflection:

God's generosity is not measured by our calculations. God does not give love, mercy, or grace according to what we think someone deserves. The parable reminds us that God's goodness is not a limited supply that we have to compete for. Another person's blessing does not diminish ours.

So, we ask ourselves:

- When have I found myself comparing what I receive with what someone else receives? What does this reveal? About my attitude toward God?
- Is there someone whose good fortune or blessing I find difficult to celebrate? Can I ask God to free me from envy?
- Who are the "last" people in my community or in my life? How might Jesus be inviting me to see and treat them differently?

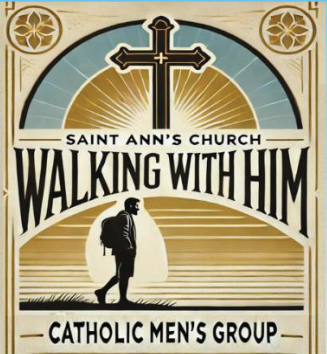

Parish Columbarium & Memorial Garden Survey Results

St. Ann Catholic Church is exploring the potential development of a Parish Columbarium & Memorial Garden on the site of the former convent building. This summary presents the results of **the parish-wide survey conducted during May–July 2026** as part of the Bishop-approved exploratory phase and identifies key findings to guide continued discernment, planning, and consultation.

The survey was not intended to serve as a referendum on a final project. Rather, it was designed to assess parish awareness, gauge support for continued exploration, identify questions and concerns requiring further discussion, and provide parish leadership with meaningful input before advancing to the **Diocese of Arlington - Phase 1 Building Commission Review**.

The survey produced **335 completed responses**, representing approximately **20% of parish households**.

¿Y si quiero darle a este último lo mismo que a ti? ¿Acaso no soy libre de hacer lo que quiera con mi propio dinero?

¿Sientes envidia porque soy generoso?

«Así, los últimos serán los primeros, y los primeros serán los últimos».

Reflexión:

La generosidad de Dios no se mide según nuestros cálculos. Dios no otorga amor, misericordia ni gracia basándose en lo que creemos que alguien merece. La parábola nos recuerda que la bondad de Dios no es un recurso limitado por el cual debamos competir. La bendición de otra persona no disminuye la nuestra.

Así, que nos preguntamos:

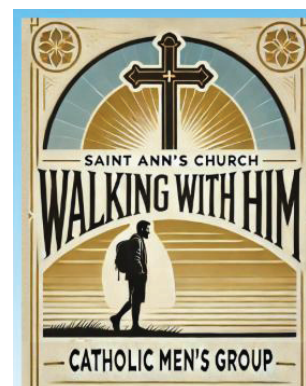
