Corpus Christi Ministry Spotlight: **Events Ministry**

What We Do: The main purpose of the events committee is to facilitate the building of community & fellowship within the church. The committee has the following responsibilities: Plan social events for the congregation that facilitates community building and fun. This includes annual or bi-annual events such as church picnics, spaghetti dinners, assisting in the 5K Fun Run; assisting the fundraising committee. - Awareness: Revisit the times in the past twenty-four hours when you were and were not the best-version-of-yourself. Talk to God about these situations and what you learned from them
- Significant Moments: Identify something you experienced in the last twenty-four hours and explore what God might be trying to say to you through that event (or person).
- Peace: Ask God to forgive you for any wrong you have committed (against yourself, another person, or Him) and to fill you with a deep and abiding peace.
- Freedom: Speak with God about how He is inviting you to change your life, so that you can experience the freedom to be the-best-version-of-yourself.
- Others: Lift up to God anyone you feel called to pray for today, asking God to bless and guide them.
- Pray the *Our Father*.


