# From the Pastor

## FROM GREEN TO GOLD — March 22, 2026

Today we begin the increasingly intense portion of Lent called Passiontide. The statues, crucifixes, and other images have been covered in violet cloth creating a certain starkness in the church. This is to elicit a greater sense of solemnity and reverence as we march towards Holy Week. That begins next Sunday and opens Holy Week, the most intense week of the Church year. It concludes with the three important days of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday. Those days lead us to the festive, glorious celebration of the resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ on Easter Sunday. Before the feast is the sacrifice and that intensifies today. As we continue our Lenten practices, we might want to be praying for peace, especially right now in the Mideast. Additionally, due in part to what is happening there, some are really struggling with the price of gas. Many were already challenged financially with the rather high cost of living. No doubt, our parish has been facing that hardship as well. Sadly, there are some other major issues facing us, such as the Extreme Abortion Amendment here in Virginia. I have written about it, you have heard about it from our bishop, and unfortunately it has now met with legislative approval in two consecutive sessions, meaning we will now vote on it on November 3<sup>rd</sup>. If this amendment is then passed by the general populace of Virginia, abortion with nearly no restrictions will be enshrined in our state. It says there is a fundamental right to abortion and will make Virginia the only Southern state to have constitutional protection for abortion. Virginia once was a strong proponent of common sense, but no more, and it may soon get worse.

This past Monday I attended a diocesan meeting where the director of the diocesan pro-life office and the executive director of the Virginia Catholic Conference in Richmond spoke extensively about the seriousness of this situation. It really is evil incarnate. It truly is extreme, and our hope and prayer need to be that this amendment does NOT pass the popular vote. So, we need to vote this November. We also need to encourage others to vote for truth and goodness. You will be hearing much more about this, as it is that devastating, potentially. It takes Virginia down a path, actually a highway, of evil, as it is truly catastrophic to "declare" a tragedy to be a right. Let's be honest here, abortion is the murder of babies. There can be some real challenges for some women who are pregnant and we have a duty to be there for them, to help them, and try to provide for them. But the answer is not to kill the baby, this most vulnerable, innocent creation of God, a person, not a "clump of cells." This amendment will also have an impact on parental consent, on conscience protections for healthcare providers, and other matters of concern. Again, it is diabolical. Right now, we need to pray, and these remaining days of Lent are an opportunity to do that. We have one more week of the Forty Days for Life as well, so may we all pray, and work, for the sanctity of all human life, especially that of the unborn!

I do want to thank Fr. Njodzela, Deacon Ochenkowski, and Deacon Heckman for their reflections on the Cardinal Virtues. That Lenten series ended last Wednesday. My hope is that this four-part series was a help to your spiritual lives. We continue to hear confessions on Wednesday evenings until 8:00 pm. We will do that on the Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday of Holy Week. This Friday we conclude our Lenten Meals. Two Fridays ago, the PTO sponsored it, and this past Friday the Mother Teresa Outreach apostolate did. This week the Youth apostolate does, and they will host their annual Living Stations as well. I am grateful to all these apostolates for all they have done to help make this Lent more penitential and spiritually fruitful. We will hear confessions again Friday evening for the last time this Lent from 6:30 to 7:30 pm. There will be confessions on Good Friday during the day, 8:30 to 10:30 am and 12:00 noon to 2:00 pm. On Holy Saturday, April 4<sup>th</sup>, confessions will be heard from 9:00 to 10:00 am. Those are the last confessions before Easter Sunday, and on both Good Friday and Holy Saturday there should be three confessors.

I have one final item this week. Previously here I have spoken about the good things happening in my home diocese, the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. I talked about their seminary and the increase in vocations, as well as the quality of these young men. I also talked about my experience last summer at St. Josephat's Basilica in Milwaukee and at a suburban parish where my nephew was married. Last Saturday, March 14<sup>th</sup>, our diocese held a special conference for women. The week before on March 7<sup>th</sup> the diocese sponsored a conference for men. They have been doing this now for years. It's usually at St. Joseph's, just up the street from us in Herndon. I read 400 men attended their conference, and I heard, from a parishioner who was there, that about the same number of women attended their conference. Last Saturday (the 14<sup>th</sup>) in Milwaukee a Catholic men's conference was also held. Four thousand, not 400, men attended that day of prayer and talks. Amazing! Our diocese has been blessed for years, thank God, but once again, good things are happening in other dioceses which were once deserts of Faith and now have become real oases of Faith. I think we all need this, but perhaps more importantly men do. There's often talk about the "toxicity of masculinity." That sadly can exist, but we need men to be men, truly masculine, but also Christ-centered, holy men of prayer, who are good husbands and fathers. This coming Saturday, the 28<sup>th</sup>, our PTO is holding a Father-Son night, entitled "Strong Men, Strong Character." As always, despite my above comments about Virginia, there is hope! *In Christ, Fr. Kleinmann*
