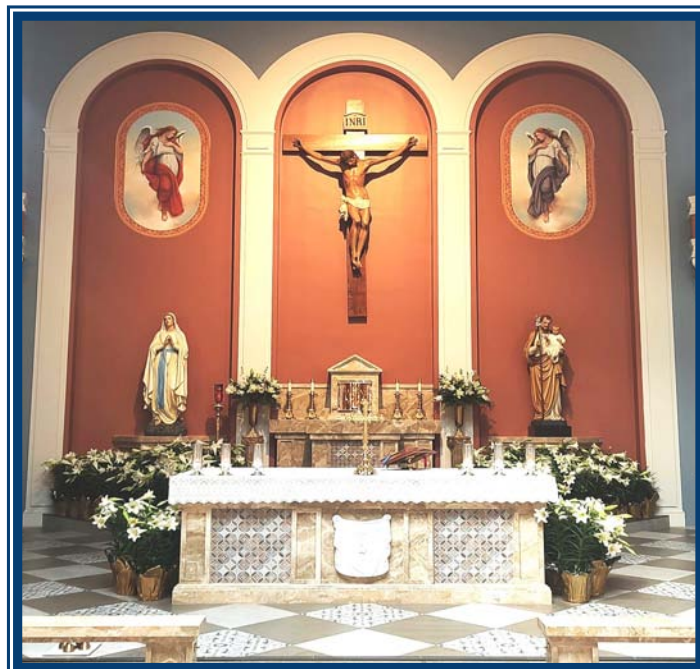

From the Pastor

FROM GREEN TO GOLD — August 30, 2026

Starting again this week with sports, I'll comment first on the Green Bay Packers, who played their second preseason game in Denver. Unlike their first game against Pittsburgh, this second game was a much better one. Green Bay dominated the Broncos from start to finish. Like the week before Jordan Love, the starting quarterback for the Packers, played only one series. But he too looked much better, very focused. The drive resulted in a touchdown, not just a field goal as in the previous game. Their new kicker, Trey Smack, again was great. He had four field goals, one for 59 yards. He is now 7 for 7 in field goal attempts in the two games. This seems to bid well for the team. They won 33-13 and had their last preseason game in Green Bay against the Arizona Cardinals this past Friday (after this column was written). Their first regular season game is September 13th in Minnesota against the Vikings. We'll see how the season goes. Secondly, the Brewers just keep plodding ahead. They took two of three games from the Braves, which was a rather pivotal series. They were facing the Mets as this column was written. They still hold the best record in the MBL (but again barely, with the Dodgers breathing down their neck). They were the first team to reach 81 wins. Their pitching is still outstanding, both with some of their starters and especially with the bullpen. Interestingly however, they have the fewest homeruns of all MLB teams. Like last year they seem to play sound, old school, basic baseball. They steal bases, they bunt, they aren't afraid to take walks, which all in turn adds runs and gains them victories. Something I haven't mentioned at all this year is the Brewers' manager, Pat Murphy. For the past two years he was the National League Manager of the Year, deservedly. Quite simply, the team thrives under his leadership. At 67 years old he is the oldest manager in baseball. He was a college coach for most of his career, including Arizona State and Notre Dame. He previously was a bench coach for the Brewers before becoming their manager. He has far exceeded any expectations anyone had for him. He just seems to trust his players, holds them accountable, but really cares about them. He breeds team spirit. As one commentator said of the "Murphy magic," he does it with "love, discipline, and an uncanny ability to connect with people." He really is the key to the Brewers' success.

What Pat Murphy is to the Brewers is really what every leader should be to those he or she is leading. That includes and in some ways is especially true of the Church. This past week the Gospel passages on Tuesday and Wednesday had Our Lord taking the Pharisees to task for their hypocrisy, their lack of leadership. He wanted them to teach and preach the truth, but also to live it. That is what we should expect from our Church leaders as well. We should want them to love us, to hold us accountable, to demand that we follow the disciplines of our Faith. They should also be approachable and certainly need to be living a holy, virtuous life. Their actions should speak louder than their words. Thankfully, I believe that is what Bishop Burbidge is for our diocese. I hope that is what I am for this parish and its parishioners. I think I generally am approachable. I truly try to teach and preach the truth. I believe I strive to hold you, and myself, accountable. I do indeed love you and this parish, but here I perhaps could do better at times, as I could perhaps do more. If that were true, maybe our finances would be in better shape. I also do strive for personal holiness, but here too I could do better. I could be more prayerful and a bit more charitable. I think I need to be a bit more involved. I think with age I have somewhat waned on that. I promise you I will try!

Why I raise all the above is that a very serious matter looms over us and we will confront it head-on this November. That issue is the three proposed amendments to the Virginia Constitution. You have already heard about this and will hear more in the weeks ahead. Early voting begins in two weeks. These amendments deal with the sanctity of life, the sanctity of marriage, and the voting rights of those who have been incarcerated. The last issue is a matter of prudential judgment. It is one's own decision where to go with that, although the Virginia bishops are recommending that we allow this. The first two issues, on the other hand, are of the utmost importance. God is the author of human life and marriage. To permit the taking, really the murder, of an unborn baby with basically no restrictions right up to (and even beyond) birth is downright evil. It plays right into the hand of Satan. Although nationally same sex marriage is permitted, currently Virginia law prohibits it. Like abortion, if this were ever overturned nationally, our state would protect the marriage of a man and woman, but not if this amendment passes. Therefore, our bishop, as am I, is imploring on us to vote "no" on these two items. I hope his leadership and mine are a further reason to do so. Our eternal salvation depends on this. Again, you will hear more about this. Please pray for this. Please ask Our Lord to keep our beloved Virginia a place of love and truth, not of hatred and evil. *In Christ, Fr. Kleinmann*

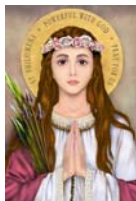
Join Us to Pray and Be a Witness for Life!

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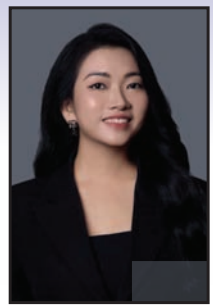
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
