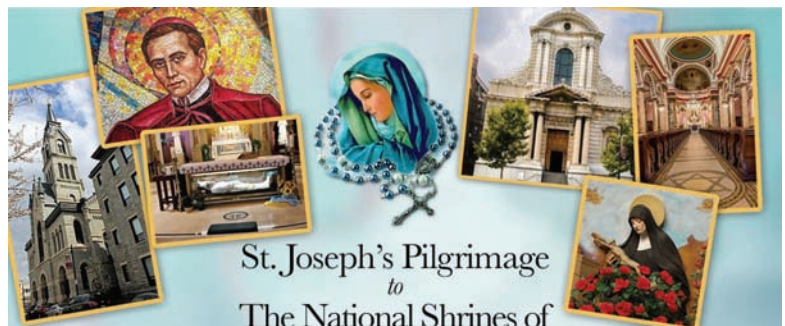

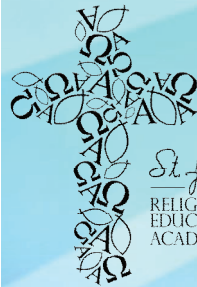

Los casos graves de infección por Salmonella pueden tener importantes implicaciones para la salud, afectando órganos como el sistema urinario, el torrente sanguíneo, los huesos, las articulaciones o el sistema nervioso. El diagnóstico se basa en pruebas de laboratorio para detectar la bacteria Salmonella en las heces, los tejidos corporales o los fluidos de un individuo. La mayoría de los casos la infección por Salmonella se resuelve en un plazo de cuatro a siete días sin necesidad de tratamiento con antibióticos. Sin embargo, es imperativo resaltar que las personas que padecen enfermedades graves, las que tienen un sistema inmunológico comprometido, las personas mayores de 50 años con afecciones médicas existentes, los bebés menores de 12 meses y los adultos mayores de 65 años deben recibir tratamiento con antibióticos.
