FROM THE PASTOR

My Dear Parish Family,

We find ourselves at the end of another liturgical year with the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. That seems like a mouthful to say and I was curious about why and when the feast name was changed from Christ the King to its present title. What I found surprised me: way back in 1969, Pope Paul VI changed the feast name to "Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe to emphasize Christ's universal kingship over all creation. He also changed the date of the feast to the last Sunday in Ordinary Time to stress more strongly the connection between Christ's kingship and His second *advent* (*coming*) to judge the world.

This is what Brendan Gottschall, SJ offers on this topic: Often when we think of the universe, the image that comes to mind is an expanse of space, something like the photographs taken by the Webb Space Telescope. But the *universe as a concept* refers to all that is real, the ordered reality in which we live.

When we say that Jesus is King of the Universe, it doesn't just mean that all the physical matter and forces are subject to His authority. Jesus is also King over all our loves, friends, families, societies, and the whole of human reality as well. We use similar language to talk about the physical universe and our social realities — light and darkness, movement and stillness. Jesus Christ, the image of the invisible God, is Lord over it all and has brought light from darkness and offers all of us salvation in His kingdom.

As we begin our Advent season and await the coming of Christ, the Light of the World it would be good for us to reflect on his kingship over us all as he welcomes us in from the darkness and into his own wonderful light.

Before I close just a quick couple notes on how we receive Holy Communion. Even before you get on line to come forward for the Blessed Sacrament, make sure to take a moment to prepare yourself to receive the true presence of our God in the Eucharist. As you stand or kneel and you hear the words, "Body of Christ," respond out loud with "Amen!" — not *Thank You or I believe*. And remember that you are receiving Holy Communion not taking it. So please open your hands and allow the host to be placed in your palm. Do not reach to take it out of the person's hand who is administering the Eucharist. Thank you and may God bless you all and *Oremus pro invicem*.

MENSAJE DEL PARROCO

Queridos Parroquianos,

Nos encontramos al final de otro año litúrgico con la celebración de la “Solemnidad de Jesucristo, Rey del Universo. Y me dio curiosidad por saber el por qué y el cuándo se le cambio el nombre y la fecha a esta fiesta que antes se conocía como la celebración de Cristo Rey. La respuesta es sorprendente. En 1969 el Papa Pablo VI cambio el nombre de la fiesta a “Solemnidad de Jesucristo, Rey del Universo”, con la intención de hacer énfasis en el reinado universal de Cristo sobre toda la creación. También cambio la fecha al último domingo del año litúrgico, que es el domingo antes del comienzo de Adviento con el fin de resaltar la conexión que hay entre Cristo Rey y Su segundo adviento que corresponde al regreso de Cristo como Rey para juzgar al mundo.

El señor Brendan Gottschall SJ dice sobre este tema lo siguiente: a menudo cuando pensamos en el universo la imagen que nos viene a la mente es la del espacio, algo parecido a las fotografías tomadas por el telescopio espacial Webb. Pero el universo como concepto se refiere a todo lo real, la realidad en la que vivimos. Cuando decimos que Jesucristo es el Rey Del Universo no solo significa que todo lo físico y material esta sujeto a Su autoridad, sino que también Jesús es Rey de nuestros amores, amigos, familias, sociedades y sobre toda la humanidad. Usamos un lenguaje muy similar para hablar sobre el universo y nuestras realidades – Luz y oscuridad, movimiento y quietud. Jesucristo, la imagen del Dios invisible, es el Señor sobre todo y nos da luz sobre las tinieblas y nos ofrece la salvación en Su reino.

Durante el comienzo de esta temporada de adviento y en la espera de la venida de Cristo, la luz del Mundo, sería bueno que reflexionáramos sobre Su reinado sobre nosotros mientras nos da la bienvenida de la oscuridad hacia su maravillosa luz.

Antes de terminar quisiera añadir un par de notas breves acerca de cómo prepararnos para recibir la Sagrada Comunión. Antes de hacer la fila para recibir el sacramento tómese un momento para prepararse para recibir la verdadera presencia de Nuestro Señor en la Eucaristía. Cuando escuches las palabras “Cuerpo de Cristo”, responde en voz alta AMEN!. No se responde con un yo creo o gracias. Recuerda que estas recibiendo la Sagrada Comunión, no tomándola. También por favor abran sus manos para que les entreguen la hostia. No intenten quitársela de la mano a la persona que les está administrando la eucaristía. Gracias y que Dios los bendiga y Oremus pro invicem (*Oremos unos por otros*).

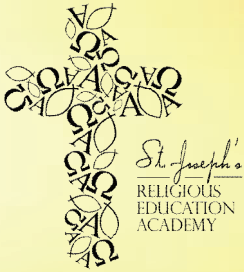

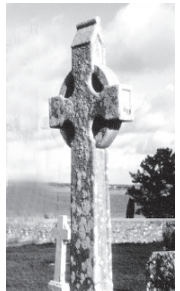
