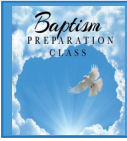

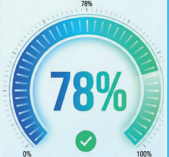

FROM THE PASTOR

My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On this day that we celebrate the Solemnity of the Ascension of our Lord Jesus, I share with you a beautiful reflection by Joel Schorn: The English author and scholar C. S. Lewis once wrote, *"In the Christian Story, God descends to re-ascend."* *With the exception of Jesus' final return, Lewis' words nicely bookend the big moments of Christ's life: Incarnation, ministry, death, Resurrection, and Ascension, just as the Ascension itself sums up who Jesus was and is.*

Even the readings this week talk about these major moments. The beginning of the Acts of the Apostles says "all that Jesus did and taught" would be the basis for the story to come of the early church. That's a reminder that in hearing about the early Christian community we have to keep everything that happened before firmly in mind. Also in Acts, the resurrected Christ spoke of his central teaching, the kingdom of God, and promised the gift of his enduring presence in the Spirit. The Letter to the Ephesians talks about Jesus' glorification and the access believers in him have to it. And the gospel tells of the command to Christ's followers to go forth and make new members of his body.

In the celebration of the Ascension of the Lord we have just about all we need to know.

The only thing I would say to all this is that having all we need to know is not quite enough. You and I are called to act upon what has been revealed to us. You and I need to be open to the manifold graces that God affords us so that we, with the Holy Spirit as our Advocate, can begin to understand the depths of God's love for us and the power of his grace that leads us into his own wonderful light.

This weekend we give thanks to God for the gift that Deacon Frank McKenna has been to our parish for some thirty years as he and his dear wife, Joanne move south to be with their family. Deacon Frank came to our parish shortly after I left St. Joseph's (my first time around) in 1994. Since then he has been involved in just about every aspect of parish life throughout these years. Please pray for him and Joanne that they continue to let their light shine in all they do for our Lord and his Church.

God bless you all and *Oremus pro invicem.*

The St. Joseph's Social Concerns Mission this year is to assist Ocean County's homeless veterans living here in our midst.

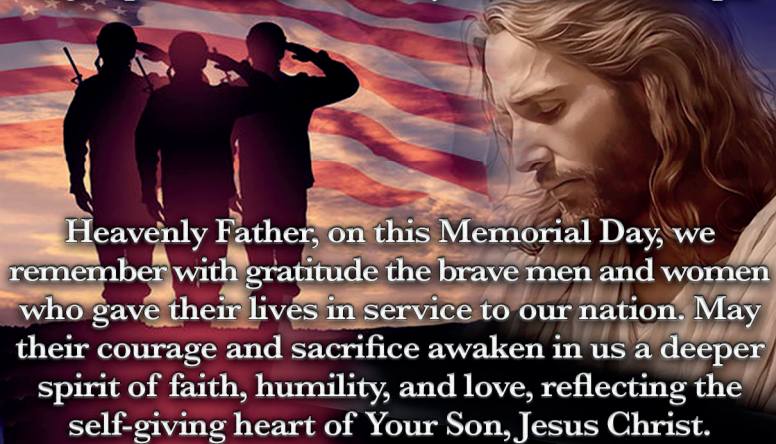

MENSAJE DEL PARROCO

Mis Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas en Cristo,

En este día en que celebramos la Solemnidad de la Ascensión de nuestro Señor Jesús, comparto con ustedes una hermosa reflexión de Joel Schorn: El autor y erudito inglés C. S. Lewis escribió una vez: «En la historia Cristiana, Dios desciende para volver a ascender». *Con la excepción del regreso final de Jesús, las palabras de Lewis enmarcan perfectamente los grandes momentos de la vida de Cristo: la Encarnación, el ministerio, la muerte, la Resurrección y la Ascensión; tal como la propia Ascensión resume quién fue y quién es Jesús.*

Incluso las lecturas de esta semana hablan de estos momentos importantes. El comienzo de los Hechos de los Apóstoles dice que «todo lo que Jesús hizo y enseñó» sería la base para la historia futura de la Iglesia primitiva. Esto nos recuerda que al escuchar sobre la primera comunidad cristiana, debemos tener muy presente de todo lo que sucedió anteriormente. También en los Hechos, el Cristo resucitado habló de su enseñanza central el Reino de Dios, y prometió el don de su presencia perdurable en el Espíritu. La Carta a los Efesios habla de la glorificación de Jesús y del acceso que los creyentes en Él tienen a ella. Y el Evangelio relata el mandato dado a los seguidores de Cristo de salir y hacer nuevos miembros de su Cuerpo.

En la celebración de la Ascensión del Señor tenemos casi todo lo que necesitamos saber.

Lo único que añadiría a todo esto es que tener todo lo que necesitamos saber no es del todo suficiente. Ustedes y yo estamos llamados a actuar conforme a lo que se nos ha revelado. Ustedes y yo necesitamos estar abiertos a las múltiples gracias que Dios nos concede para que con el Espíritu Santo como nuestro Abogado podamos comenzar a comprender la profundidad del amor de Dios por nosotros y el poder de su gracia que nos conduce hacia su propia y maravillosa luz.

Este fin de semana damos gracias a Dios por el don que el diácono Frank McKenna ha sido para nuestra parroquia durante unos treinta años, ya que él y su querida esposa, Joanne, se mudan al sur para estar con su familia. El diácono Frank llegó a nuestra parroquia poco después de que yo dejara San José (en mi primera etapa a) en 1994. Desde entonces, ha estado involucrado en prácticamente todos los aspectos de la vida parroquial a lo largo de estos años. Por favor, oren por él y por Joanne, para que sigan haciendo brillar su luz en todo lo que realizan para nuestro Señor y su Iglesia.

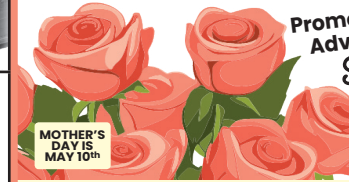
