WHAT'S IN YOUR HEART?

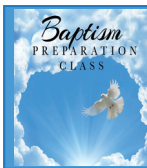

If you are making plans for a "destination wedding," please call the parish office first. There is a way to receive the Sacrament of Matrimony before your destination wedding.

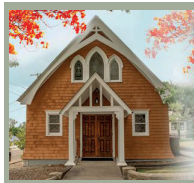

St Joseph's Church provides a Summer Religious Education Academy (formerly known as CCD) for the children of our parish families who attend public school and are in grades 1-8. Our hope is that the seeds we plant in the summer are reinforced in the children throughout the academic year by weekly mass attendance and participation in the various aspects

of parish and family life, including our optional Academy Card activities.

Our optional Academy Card activities are designed to provide additional opportunities for students and their families to physically live out their faith and grow deeper in the love of God and the practice of our Catholic Faith.

At your child's first Academy Card activity, he/she will receive an Academy Card and their first stamp. At each subsequent event, they will receive another stamp on their card. While we hope that your child attends as many events as possible, receiving 4 stamps earns Early Registration for the 2027 Summer Academy (week of your choice!) AND a \$50 discount off your child's total registration fee.

NOTE: Each student must be accompanied by an adult for all Academy Card events.

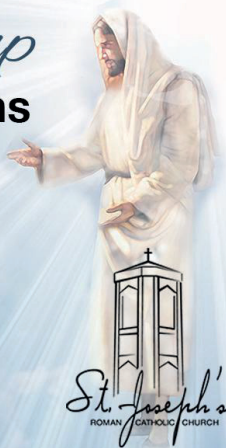

In the Catholic tradition, food safety is not just about public health; it reflects faith, respect for human dignity, and stewardship of creation. Ensuring food is safe and ethically handled is a moral duty that honors God and protects others.

The Human Body as a Temple

Catholics view the body as a "temple of the Holy Spirit" (1 Corinthians 6:19), and food safety practices align with the Fifth Commandment. Keeping food hygienic respects the life God created.

Food Safety as a Work of Mercy

Catholic social teaching emphasizes the importance of safe food for vulnerable populations, stating that providing unsafe food contradicts true charity. This involves responsible stewardship that balances waste reduction with health.

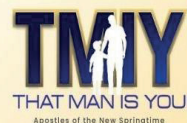
Ethical Stewardship

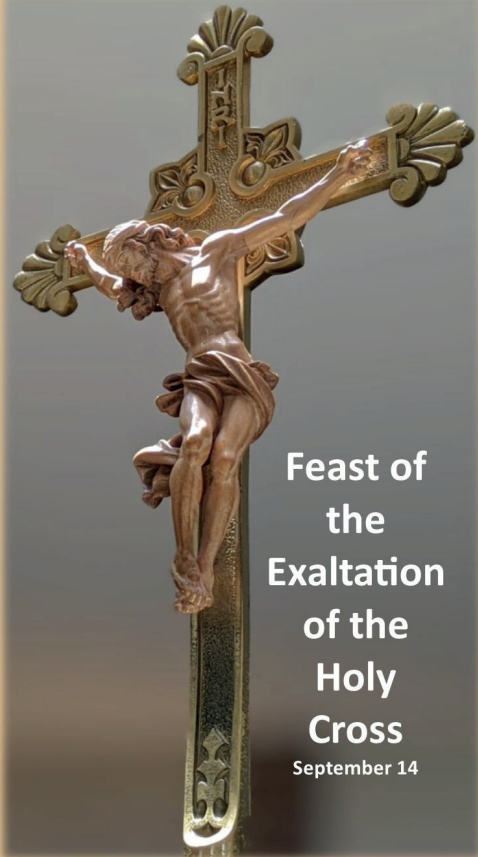

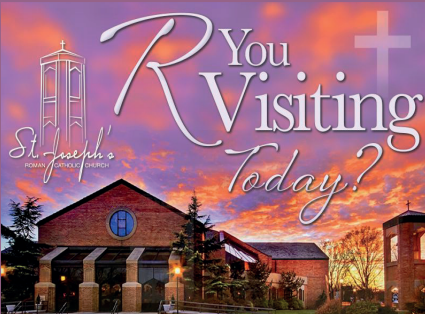

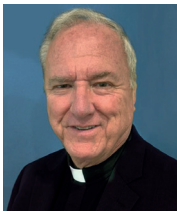

Sí, era una de nuestras pequeñas dirigiéndose a su primer día de clases. ¡Me encanta! Espero y rezo para que todos nuestros pequeños estudiantes tengan un año escolar maravilloso.

El viernes fue un día para recordar aquel día de hace 25 años que cambió nuestro mundo. El 11 de Septiembre se convirtió en una fecha en la que todos podían decir exactamente dónde estaban y qué hacían cuando se enteraron de la noticia de los aviones que se estrellaron contra el World Trade Center en Nueva York, el Pentágono en Washington D.
