

A Note from the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

January 22nd is the 51st anniversary of the Supreme Court decision, Roe vs. Wade, when abortion was legalized in all 50 states in the U.S. That decision was overturned about one year ago but what actually happened was that individual states had to decide if abortion would be legal in a given state and under what circumstances. The results have been mixed, to say the least. Some states, like New York, have virtually no restriction on the procedure, and others have near total restrictions on abortion. It is sad to hear states like New York inviting women from everywhere to come here for an abortion. On the other hand, it is terrible to hear that, in some states, a woman who has had a miscarriage can be charged with murder or abuse of a corpse. There are some heart wrenching things happening around the country with regard to all of this. If only, we could let nature take it course and cherish life from conception until natural death.

Even though the March for Life is on January 19th this year, a time to either gather in Washington (as some of our parishioner did) or pray for a greater respect for life from wherever we are, there is another day to join in prayer as well.

January 22nd is the day, <u>every year</u>, that all dioceses of the United States observe "a day of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion." It would be wonderful, practically a miracle, if every person could rejoice in the gift of life that comes from God and to pray for those who are tempted to think abortion is somehow good. Pray and sacrifice so that every person, born and unborn, is respected, loved and cared for. Let us do whatever we can to support those who have to make difficult decisions - that they may choose life.


