A Note from the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

Since the beginning of December we have increased the hours of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Once the Pandemic began, we canceled all hours of Exposition in the Chapel due to small space and no windows. However, almost immediately we began to have Exposition of the Sacrament from a window in the Family Education Center. It was better than no Adoration at all. Eventually, the hours changed and then the weather was too hot and finally too cold. At that point, Adoration took place in the Main Church for an hour a day five days a week. It was that way until the beginning of December. Quite a few people were asking for more hours of Exposition of the Sacrament until finally it was time to open the Chapel. It almost seemed that the Pandemic had faded away but, unfortunately COVID is making something of a comeback. Right now there are no official restrictions (like facemasks) but that could happen again. Just be careful and wear a mask if you feel the need or feel sick. Rather, stay home if you feel sick.

At the present moment, very few people are coming to Adoration. Sometimes no one is there at 4:30pm. Sometimes no one is there at closing. Sometimes no one is there for most of the hours.

We are trying our best to make Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament available but perhaps people have forgotten its benefits. It is true that prayer anywhere is powerful, or in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament in the tabernacle, but there is something even more spiritual and powerful about the Blessed Sacrament exposed in the Monstrance. We shall see how the hours change for Lent, but the Sisters of Life are coming to offer a Day of Retreat focused on the Eucharist on February 24th. May the Retreat Day help us to focus our mind and heart on the love of God and the presence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament even more!


