Feast of the Presentation of the Lord
Friday, February 2, 2024

*Almighty ever-living God,
we humbly implore your majesty
that, just as your only Begotten Son
was presented in the Temple
in the substance of our flesh, so, by your grace,
we may be presented to you with minds made pure.
Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son,
who lives and reigns with you in the unity
of the Holy Spirit,
God, forever and ever. Amen*

- Collect, Liturgy of the Feast
of the Presentation of the Lord.

The Gospel of Saint Luke, Chapter 2, verses 22 to 40 recounts the Presentation of the Lord by Our Lady and Saint Joseph to the Temple in Jerusalem. The Book of Leviticus – the codified laws of Moses, required the Jewish parents to present the male child to the Levitical priests as part of the “purification” of the mother after childbirth (Leviticus 12: 1-5). Our Lady knew that she was the Mother of God and Saint Joseph was well-aware of his God-given vocation as protector and foster-father of the Lord. They could have easily said, “We are of the New Covenant. There is no need to obey this seemingly inconvenient law.” But they ascribed to the law because they were devout, obedient, and faithful followers of Judaism. Humility is the overarching message – as many theologians and spiritual writers have attested, Our Lady and Saint Joseph also followed the Mosaic law regarding purification and presentation laws so as not to call attention to this amazing gift in their midst – the Infant Savior. Our Lord's hidden life would precede his public ministry as the Redeemer.

There is an important lesson here. If Our Lady and Saint Joseph followed the Mosaic law – again, which was not necessary for them since the Messiah was literally under their familial roof, who are we as Catholics to pick and choose those teachings suit us and which may appear extraneous or outdated? Following the teachings of Christ is the ultimate manifestation of trust and love. There are objective truths of which to be adhered. Our Lady and Saint Joseph remind us of the importance of trust and submission to the loving and salvific teachings of Christ as presented in the Church. Chesterton once said (and I paraphrase) that people have a tendency to disregard revealed truths, but will embrace as dogma, the new and ersatz whims, trends, and fads.

The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord is also World Day of Consecrated Life. We have our own

consecrated community right here in Hyde Park – the Focolare Movement's Mariapolis Luminosa on Cardinal Road. We pray in a special way for the generous men and women of the Focolare Movement, who have consecrated their lives in service of the Church. And how blessed is our parish also to have one of our parishioners, Brother Patrick Mary Bubel, O.P, in simple vows with the Order of Preachers (Dominicans). We pray for Brother Patrick Mary who is completing his philosophy program the Dominican House of Studies in Washington, D.C., and in September will begin the theological studies on the road to the priesthood.

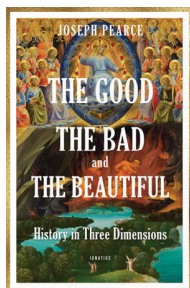

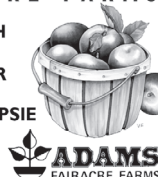
