

FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT- MARCH 17. 2024

The Fifth Sunday of Lent March 17, 2024 **Passiontide**

Many of us will most certainly recall what was once known as "Passion Sunday," that is, the Fifth Sunday of Lent. Although Passion Sunday was abrogated with the Missal of Paul VI of 1969, beginning with the Fifth Sunday of Lent, the priest uses the Preface prayers of the Passion of the Lord right through the Triduum, beginning with the Mass of Thursday of the Lord's Supper (Holy Thursday). In recent years, beginning with the Fifth Sunday of Lent, there has been a return to the veiling of statues and crucifixes in many churches. In his 1998 work, Milestones: A Memoir, 1927-1977, the late Cardinal Joseph Ratzinger (Pope Benedict XVI) recounts the drama of Passiontide in interwar-era Bavaria, and all its liturgical intensity, where not only the statues were veiled, but the stained-glass windows were covered as well.

The practice of veiling statues in violet or red on the Fifth Sunday of Lent can be traced back to ninth century Germany. The visual impact of veiled statues reminded the faithful of the heightened sense of solemnity. I remember as a child being fascinated by the church at Passiontide. There was a real sense of urgency and maybe a little sadness. I truly believe that all these gestures and visuals helped in my vocation to the priesthood.

We need visuals, because we are created beings. And the Second Person of the Holy Trinity took on human flesh so that we can be redeemed. Created goodness – the human person as the capstone of such, has been elevated to a new dignity as a result of the Incarnation.

Art, architecture, liturgical beauty and dignity are not luxuries – they are necessities! Blessed Passiontide, Fr. Michael Morris






