The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed

Sunday, November 2, 2025

Yesterday, the Church commemorated All Saints, where we pray in thanksgiving for all saints – recognized by the Church through canonization, as well as those who may not have been elevated to the altars of the Church, but enjoy blessedness in Heaven – of course which we all aspire. Today, the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed, we pray for those who lived lives of virtue, but are still in need of purification in Purgatory. We read in the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* (second edition, 1997):

All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly

purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death,

they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter

the joys of Heaven. (#1030)

The Catechism continues:

The Church gives the name *Purgatory* to this final purification of the

elect, which is entirely different from the punishment of the damned. The Church

formulated her doctrine of faith on Purgatory especially in the Councils

of Florence (1431-1445) and Trent (1545-1563). The tradition of the Church,

by reference to certain texts of Scripture, speaks of a cleansing fire...(#1031)

The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (aka All Souls Day) is so important in the life of the Church, that the All Souls liturgies will supplant liturgical worship for the Thirty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time. And so, we are reminded to pray for all our deceased relatives and friends, that they may enjoy blessedness in Heaven.

Food Baskets for Thanksgiving

Thanksgiving is a time of blessings. Every year we at Regina Coeli, donate dozens of food baskets to families in need throughout the Hyde Park area. God bless you for your kind generosity to our neighbors in need. Sign-up sheets will soon be in the Church vestibules to allow time to prepare for our pick-up date Sunday, November 23rd (the Sunday before Thanksgiving).

Be mindful of the number of people you are serving. Many families do not have the means to store or prepare huge turkeys. *Please do not pack pies on their sides as they crumble and fall apart.* Except turkeys, <u>frozen foods should not be included in your basket.</u> Fresh or canned produce and refrigerated products are good choices.

FOOD BANK ideas to help you create a holiday box for a family of 4 people. These are suggestions and do not have to be included. If your basket is for a larger number of people, multiply accordingly. Stuffing Mix, Dessert Mix (Cake, Brownies...)Boxed Potatoes, Cookies/Crackers, Juice/Drink Mix Cranberry Sauce, Canned Sweet Potatoes, Rice/Pasta, Canned Corn, Carrots, Peas, Beans or Mixed Vegetables, Macaroni & Cheese, Cereal, Pancake Mix, Peanut Butter & Jelly, Canned Tuna, Mayo, Canned Tomatoes/Spaghetti Sauce Soup.






