





A Message from our Pastor


With family roots in County Kerry, Ireland, I wish you all a Happy Saint Patrick's Day and blessings on all of you as we celebrate the Solemnity of Saint Joseph on this Tuesday, March 19.

This year and in recent years during Lent, we have used Option B of the Act of Penitence in the Introductory Rites of the Mass. Commonly we use Option A ("I confess to almighty God, and to you my brothers and sisters . . .") and Option C (i.e. an invocation with "Lord, have mercy. Christ, have mercy"). All three options are available for use at any Mass during the course of the year. Using Option B throughout the season of Lent helps remind us of the significance of our Lenten journey together as we acknowledge our sins and celebrate the gift of divine mercy. During the Easter season, instead of these three options of the Act of Penitence, we pivot to the rite of blessing and sprinkling of water. This rite recalls our baptism and thus highlights the "common priest-hood of the faithful."

When we use any option of the Act of Penitence during the Introductory Rites of the Mass, we are not examining our conscience or listing particular sinful acts. The purpose of the Act of Penitence at Mass in its particular forms is not to replace the sacrament of reconciliation or to turn us inward into a review of our sins. The Act of Penitence moves to an acknowledgement that the community at worship stands before a merciful God. The proclamation of the word of God makes penitence possible for all of us. A penitential person is open and receptive to the word and life of Christ. We acknowledge our own sins and praise God for the wondrous gift of God's mercy revealed in Jesus Christ and renewed in our hearts by the power of the Holy Spirit.

The Old Testament book *Sirach* (a.k.a. *Ecclesiasticus*) was first written in Hebrew in the years 200 B.C. and 175 B.C. Chapter Two of that books gives explicit instructions to someone who wants to serve the LORD. Verse 18 of Chapter Two makes reference to God and says, "For equal to his majesty is the mercy that he shows." How could we not praise God for God's mercy when we gather for Sunday Mass?


