**January 7th Statement of****Archbishop Bernard Hebda of Minneapolis-St. Paul**

“Following this morning’s deadly shooting in Minneapolis, I reiterate my plea for all people of good will to join me in prayer for the person who was killed, for their loved ones, and for our community.

“We continue to be at a time in this country when we need to lower the temperature of rhetoric, stop fear-filled speculation and start seeing all people as created in the image and likeness of God. That is as true for our immigrant sisters and brothers as it is for our elected officials and those who are responsible for enforcing our laws. I echo today the repeated call of the U.S. Catholic bishops that we come together as a nation and pass meaningful immigration reform that does justice to all parties. The longer we refuse to grapple with this issue in the political arena, the more divisive and violent it becomes.

“It is only by working together — with God’s help — that we will have peace in our communities, state and world.”

**YEAR OF GRACE 2026**

*By decree of the Apostolic Penitentiary issued January 10, 2026, at the behest of His Holiness Pope Leo XIV, the Church has proclaimed a special Year of St. Francis, from January 10, 2026, to January 10, 2027, on the occasion of the 800<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the passage of St. Francis of Assisi into Heaven. This decree grants, throughout the entire period, the possibility of obtaining a plenary indulgence.*

The Pope presents this time as a gift for the entire Church, not just for the Franciscan Family, so that the 800<sup>th</sup> anniversary may become an occasion for authentic spiritual renewal. The decree mentions how St. Francis remains extraordinarily relevant even in our own era and invites everyone to “become saints in the contemporary world, following the example of the Seraphic Patriarch,” turning hope into real charity and a real commitment to peace.

The plenary indulgence is granted under the usual conditions: sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion, and prayer according to the intentions of the Holy Father, with a heart detached from sin. It may also be applied in suffrage for the souls in Purgatory. It may be obtained by members of the Franciscan Family, ecclesial communities inspired by the charism of St. Francis, and all the faithful. During the Year of St. Francis, they need only make a pilgrimage to a Franciscan church or a place of worship dedicated to St. Francis, take part in the Jubilee rites or pause in prayer and meditation, and conclude with the Our Father, the Creed, and invocations to the Blessed Virgin Mary, St. Francis of Assisi, St. Clare of Assisi, and the various Saints of the Franciscan Family.

Special consideration is given to the elderly, the sick, and those who are unable to leave their homes. They may gain the indulgence by spiritually joining in the celebrations and offering their sufferings and prayers to God. The Apostolic Penitentiary also invites priests to make themselves widely available for the Sacrament of Reconciliation, so that this time may truly be a time of mercy.

Thus, this Year of St. Francis presents itself as a time of favor, a grace offered to all, so that—as the Pope hopes—“feelings of Christian charity toward one’s neighbor and authentic desire for harmony and peace among peoples may be reborn in hearts.”

We will have information on special parish events and celebrations during the Year of Saint Francis of Assisi in the near future.

## A Message from our Pastor

May the Lord give you peace!

Welcome to Ordinary Time in Winter! The Christmas season in the Catholic liturgical calendar began with the 4:00 pm and the 5:30 pm Vigil Masses of Christmas on Wednesday, December 24, 2025. With these Masses as the sun set, the church's liturgy moved from the season of Advent to the Season of Christmas. December 25<sup>th</sup> to January 1<sup>st</sup> mark the Octave of Christmas which culminates with the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God on January 1, 2026. The season continues with through celebration of Epiphany (in the USA January 4, 2026) and up to and including the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord (January 11, 2026). As daylight gave way to nightfall on Sunday, January 11<sup>th</sup>, the Catholic season of Christmas ended and on Monday, January 12, 2026, we entered the season of Ordinary Time.

*Universal Norms on the Liturgical Year and the General Roman Calendar* describes the season of Ordinary Time as a period of "thirty-three or thirty-four weeks in which no particular aspect of the mystery of Christ is celebrated, but rather the mystery of Christ itself is honored in its fullness" (n. 43). This season serves us in reminding us to find the extraordinary within the ordinary. In 2026, the beginning of Lent is February 18<sup>th</sup> (Ash Wednesday) which is one month from today. This first part of the Ordinary Time season happens within the two largely significant seasons of Christmas and Lent. This brief first part of Ordinary Time provides us an opportunity to reflect upon the importance of Christ's incarnation (i.e., God become human; "The Word made flesh") as well as the passion, death, and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. This season provides the active context for what Christian life is all about – to be transformed by the love of God and serve God as His disciples in the world bringing forth a kingdom of God's justice and peace.

Ordinary Time in the Winter flows from Christmas and leads us into Lent. Therefore, we reflect on the mystery of Christ in its fullness through the lens of the incarnation and points us to Christ's passion, death, and resurrection. We joyfully welcome Christ into our hearts, homes, and communities, but now it is our duty as Christians to understand what it means to be Christ in

our hearts, homes, and communities. We have this opportunity in Ordinary Time to reflect on the way of Christ works in, through, and within us.

With Ash Wednesday only thirty days away, you may start to think about "what I want to give up for Lent" or what "what I want to do for Lent." Perhaps this year, instead of just thinking about "giving up" something tangible (e.g. candy, soft drinks, etc.) and instead of thinking about "doing something" for Lent, I would like to suggest something. Can we all think about, "For Lent, I am going to give up 1-2 hours of my free time and give those 1-2 hours to doing something in the parish?" We can all give up some screen time or time laying around the house or time binging on television re-runs. If we do, can we invest that time (possibly one to two hours in a week) in getting more involved in parish life?

Recently, a Swiss catechist wrote to Pope Leo XIV and shared her frustration with low Mass attendance and unenthusiastic participation in catechesis in her small rural parish. In her letter Nunzia, the catechist, explains how "in Switzerland, it is difficult to get parents involved and, sometimes, even children and young people to trust in God." She wrote, "I sow seeds, but the seedlings struggle to grow. Children and families prefer sports and parties," she writes, adding how families are often indifferent to religious practice and Churches seem to be increasingly emptier or populated by the elderly.

Pope Leo XIV responded, writing "The problem is not the numbers — which, of course, makes one reflect — but the increasingly evident lack of awareness in feeling part of the Church, that is, of being living members of the Body of Christ, all with unique gifts and roles, and not merely users of the sacred, of the sacraments, perhaps out of mere habit." The Pope also offers an encouragement to Nunzia, and all who experience similar difficulties. "As Christians, we always need conversion. And we must seek it together," he writes. He recalls that the true door of faith "is the Heart of Christ, always wide open."

How do we get closer to the heart of Christ? How do we feel more a part of the Parish of Saint Junipero Serra? Tell us how the parish can help you feel more a part of the parish. We need each other to grow in faith and holiness. Just something to think about in Ordinary Time in the Winter.
