Anointing of the Sick & Communion to the Homebound: Can be arranged by contacting the Parish Office. Please do not wait until the last moment.

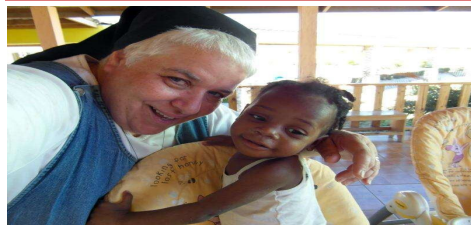
PARISH MEMBERSHIP

2. Fill out the Contact tag that is with that paper and place it in the basket on the table in the Narthex, so that we may update you on your Spiritually Adopted child.
3. You can expect to get updates on the progress of this child including a Gender reveal and the ability to name the child.
