

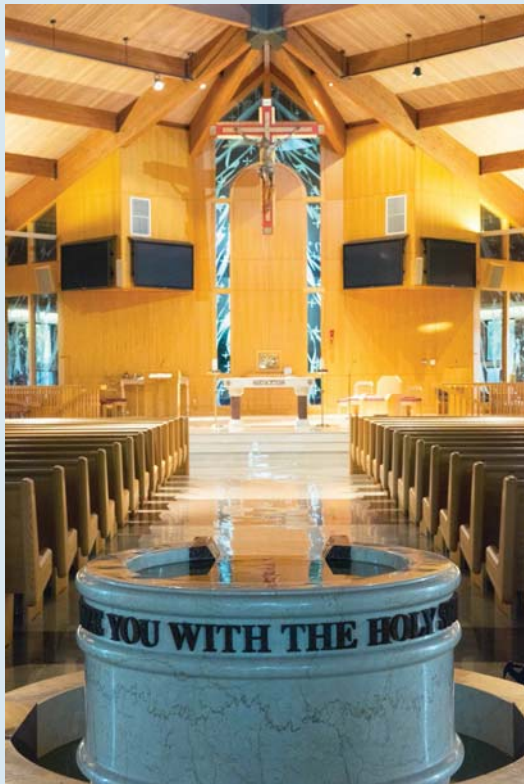

Hello RE Families,

The time is FINALLY here! I'm so sorry that this is coming later than I originally said. I wanted to launch registration with our new website, but I don't want to wait any longer. Now everyone can register their children for the full-year Religious Education program. Attached you will find the FULL schedule, including the special dates for sacramental students and our "Back to Church" Night for parents/guardians.

INFORMATION TO KNOW BEFORE REGISTRATION:

Religious Education Sessions:

MONDAY 2x per month

Session A: Mondays, 5:30pm-6:45pm - 1st-5th Grade

Session B: Mondays, 7pm-8:30pm - 6th-8th Grade

WEDNESDAY 2x per month

Session C: Wednesdays, 5:30pm-6:45pm - 1st-5th Grade

Session D: Wednesdays, 7pm-8:30pm - 6th-8th Grade

NEW Requirement: "Acts of Faith" Passports

All RE students Grades 1-8 are **required** to complete an **Acts of Faith Passport**. This means your child will **need to attend a minimum of: 6 Masses or Liturgical Events, 3 Parish Events, and do 3 Acts of Service.**

Attached you will find information about this requirement and a list of "Save the Dates" for events/opportunities we have on the calendar already. Students will receive their *Acts of Faith Passports* on the first day of classes.

Volunteers: Catechists, Confirmation Parent Leaders, & Hall/Office Aides

Volunteers are vital to the success of our Religious Education program.

1. First and foremost, we need **Catechists** to lead our students in the classrooms. ***Catechist training and resources are available to all Catechists.*** You are NOT expected to know everything or be the perfect Catholic - you're expected to have a desire to get to know your faith better and be a witness of your own story of faith to kids. If you love kids and you love Jesus, it's worth trying! We need Catechists for all grade-levels at the moment. **Please pray about this vocation!**

2. **Confirmation Parent Leaders** are needed to be discussion facilitators in classrooms. Our Confirmation curriculum is a video/discussion-based program and more adults in the room allows us to break into smaller groups. Little to no prep is involved as a Parent Leader in Confirmation classes - the Catechist does the prep work for each session.

3. **Hall & Office Aides** are such a helpful position during the sessions! I could use the extra hands signing the kids in/out for bathroom, monitoring our doors and hall, running supplies, making copies, etc. There's always tasks to complete!

***ALL VOLUNTEERS RECEIVE DISCOUNTED TUITION! RE Tuition Fees 2024-2025: - Full-Year Grades 1 & 3-6: \$125 per child**

- Sacramental Prep & Confirmation Prep Year 1 & Year 2: \$175 per child

- Summer Intensive Academy: \$250 per child

Tuition Payments can be made via [Online Giving as a one-time gift](#). You can also send cash or a check payable to St. Luke's Church in the mail or drop-off at St. Luke's Parish Office or RE Office.

Tuition for families should NOT exceed \$400. If your total with multiple children is above \$400 - you are **ONLY** to pay \$400.

*****Inability to meet payment should not deter anyone from being enrolled in our Religious Education Program.** Grants, scholarships and adjustments can always be arranged. Fee payment may be made in installments according to your family's financial situation. *Financial Assistance is available upon request, all information is private. Please email me to create a payment plan or chat about scholarships.*

Are you a parent who has kids at multiple sessions? Are you a parent who doesn't love going back and forth for pick-up & drop-off?

I've created a **Family & Parent Lounge** space on our 2nd floor. You're more than welcome to utilize that space during the sessions. If younger/older siblings need to do homework or just want to hangout so you can save on gas, I'd be happy to have you stay. You can eat dinner, bring snacks, come in to read, or have some quiet time. I have school supplies for homework and crafting needs. I also have a tea/coffee/water station. You don't *need* to drive back and forth or wait in the car!

Confirmation Prep teens can also volunteer to be Teen Helpers during their younger siblings' sessions if that would be helpful to complete their service requirement. Catechists LOVE the extra helpful hands, and so do our littles!
