

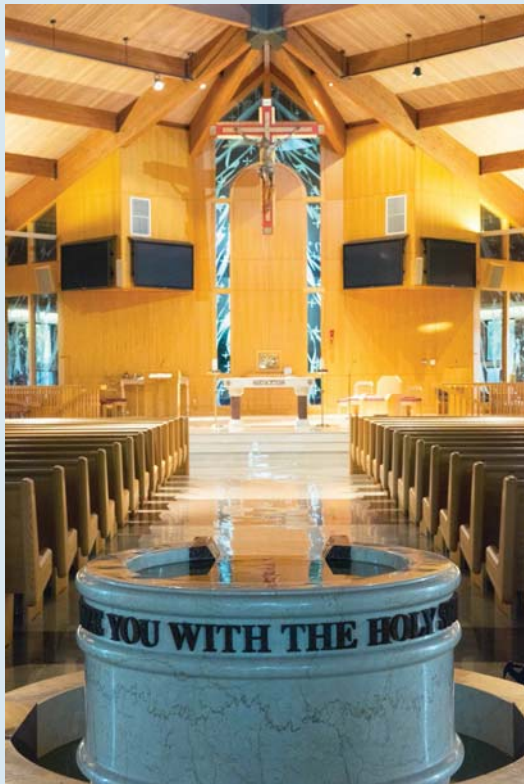

Advent begins on December 1st and lasts until December 24th. The First Sunday of Advent begins the Church's new liturgical year, (which runs in a three year cycle: Year A, B & C). The year that we are ending with the Feast of Christ the King of the Universe is Year B, during which our Sunday gospels were proclaimed primarily from the Gospel of St. Mark. On December 1st, we enter Year C during which our Sunday gospel will be proclaimed primarily from the Gospel of St. Luke.

Advent is also a time to "clean up" our hearts in order to make room for Christ's coming. To turn our focus towards the hope and promise of the coming of Christ into this world more than two thousand years ago and so to prepare ourselves for His second coming, when each one of us hopes to hear, His words to the Good Thief: "This day you will be with me in Paradise".
