



Ash Wednesday is February 18, 2026

Stations of the Cross will take place on each of the Fridays of Lent. We hope to have a variety of Stations of the Cross so that young and older alike may find spiritual nourishment from this time honored devotion. We are finalizing the schedule so that we may provide that to you.

We will also be scheduling Tenebrae. Tenebrae means “darkness” or “shadows” in Latin and is an ancient Holy Week liturgy (spoken and sung in English) that immerses us in the sorrow and solemnity of Christ’s journey to the cross. It is an incredibly powerful and moving prayer experience.

There will be increased opportunities for Adoration, Lectio Divina, Praying of the Liturgy of the Hours and more.


And to kick this all off we will have our Shrove Tuesday Pancake Dinner on February 17th.

Did you know that February 2nd is The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord-also known as Candlemas Day. This day is celebrated 40 days after the birth of Jesus, when, in accordance to Jewish law, the Blessed Mother went to the Temple in Jerusalem to be purified and to present her firstborn son to God.

Who was present, according to the Gospel of Luke? Simeon and Anna. Perhaps you might choose to engage in Lectio Divina with this Gospel passage???

And why Candlemas Day? Because Jesus is the Light of the World. It is tradition to bring candles to Church to have them blessed. Those candles then may be lit throughout the year in times of joy or sadness as a reminder of God's abiding presence and love!

Today we celebrate Sunday of the Word of God. Over the past few weeks we have mentioned this celebration and the prayer practices of Lectio Divina, Liturgy of the Hours and spending time reading the Scriptures.

The practice of Lectio Divina (Divine Reading), [Liturgy of the Hours and also reading the Bible] has a long history in the Church (Origen is credited with the first use of the term "lectio divina" in the 3rd Century: "While you attend to this lectio divina, seek aright and with unwavering faith in God the hidden sense which is present in most passages of the diving Scriptures." (Epistle to Gregory 4) and yet it seems to be a well-kept secret. And indeed it was. After Vatican II and the document Dei Verbum which encouraged lay people and wider Church to use this practice, there has been a resurgence in its exercise.

Lectio Divina is not simply reading Scripture. It is praying with Scripture. Pope Leo has said, "The gift of Scripture is God's love letter to humankind." In praying with the Scriptures, we open ourselves to an encounter with the Living God-a chance to get to know him. In Lectio Divina we can enter into a conversation with God. So praying with Scripture is not an intellectual exercise but practice of using thoughts, images, insights, and inner silence to enter into a conversation with God.
