**First Reading: Isaiah 60:1-6**

Jerusalem is extolled as a place of glory and splendor because the Lord has come to His own city.

**Second Reading: Ephesians 3:2-3a, 5-6**

Paul tells the Ephesians that his special mission is to make the Gentiles co-heirs with the Jews in Christ — "members of the same body and sharers of the promise."

**Gospel: Matthew 2:1-12**

Herod learns that Wise Men from the East are searching for the newly born Christ Child. He instructs them to find the Child and to report His whereabouts to him. The Wise Men follow a star to the place where Mary and Jesus are and offer the Child gold, frankincense, and myrrh. They do not return to Herod but follow another route to their own country.

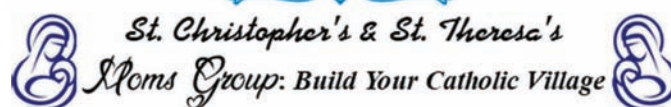

### PARISH NEWS



Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

This weekend we celebrate the great feast of the Epiphany, commemorating Christ's manifestation as the Savior, not only of the Israelites, but of all the nations. With our culture's great emphasis on the celebration of Christmas, we might be tempted to think of the Epiphany as a feast of lesser importance. But it might surprise you to know that the Church's celebration of the Epiphany actually predates its celebration of Christmas.

In the early days of the Church, it was January 6<sup>th</sup> (the traditional date of the Epiphany), in which the Church celebrated not only the visit of the Magi to the Christ Child, but also Christ's Birth, as well as His Baptism in the Jordan River and His first miracle at the Wedding at Cana. It wasn't until the late 4<sup>th</sup> century that one of the Church councils established separate dates for the celebration of Christmas on December 25<sup>th</sup> and the Epiphany on January 6<sup>th</sup>. Thus was established the 12 days of Christmas and the Christmas season as we know it today.

What a blessing it is, that as Catholics, our celebration of Christmas cannot be contained to a single day. We need different feasts and a whole season to unpack and meditate upon the great mystery and beauty of the birth of Christ.
