FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT

First Reading: Genesis 2:7-9, 3:1-7

This passage from Genesis narrates the creation of man, the temptation by the serpent, and the fall of Adam and Eve.

Second Reading: Romans 5:12-19

Paul tells the Romans that Adam's disobedience brought sin and death to the world, but Christ's dying on the cross for us will bring us salvation and life.

Gospel: Matthew 4:1-11

In preparation for His ministry, Jesus goes into the desert to fast and pray for 40 days. There He is tempted by the devil to give evidence of His miraculous powers, but Jesus resists the devil saying, "Away with you Satan! You shall do homage to the Lord your God; Him alone shall you adore."



PARISH NEWS



Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

With the season of Lent beginning, it also ushers in the season of final preparation for O.C.I.A. candidates, those men and women who will be receiving the Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil. In our community, we are blessed to have a number of candidates this year: some receiving Confirmation and First Holy Communion, one being received into the Church and receiving Confirmation and First Holy Communion, and one receiving all the Sacraments of Initiation, including Baptism. I ask that you please keep these candidates in your prayers as they begin these final weeks of preparation.

Our candidates, particularly our catechumen preparing for Baptism, will undergo a few last steps before receiving the Sacraments. The first takes place this weekend at the cathedral in Providence with Bishop Lewandowski in the Rite of Election. In the Rite of Election, "The Church makes her 'Election' or the choice and admission of catechumens who by their dispositions are fit to take part in the next celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation. It is called 'Election' because the admission made by the Church is founded on the election of God, in whose name the Church acts." (O.C.I.A., 119).

The next steps are called "The Scrutinies," which take place on the Third, Fourth, and Fifth Sundays of Lent respectively, which we will celebrate on those Sundays at our 11:00 AM Mass. "The purpose of the Scrutinies, which are brought to completion with the help of the Exorcisms, is mainly spiritual. For the Scrutinies are ordered toward liberation from sin and the Devil, and they give strength in Christ, who is the way, the truth, and the life of the elect. Moreover, the Scrutinies are set forth to purify minds and hearts, to fortify against temptations, to convert intentions, and to awaken the will, so that the elect may cling more closely to Christ and pursue more vigorously their desire to love God." (O.C.I.A., 141).
