FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

First Reading: Acts 2:14a, 36-41

With great authority, Peter proclaims to the people that the Christ who was crucified is indeed the Messiah. Urging them to reform and be baptized in the name of Christ, three thousand responded to his words and were baptized.

Second Reading: 1 Peter 2:20b-25

This is a strong exhortation from Peter to the people to endure suffering for Christ as he did for them. Healed by his wounds, they have "returned to the shepherd."

Gospel: John 10:1-10

Christ uses the beautiful image of the shepherd to describe his care for his sheep. He also says he is the sheeppate and promises that "Whoever enters through me will be safe."

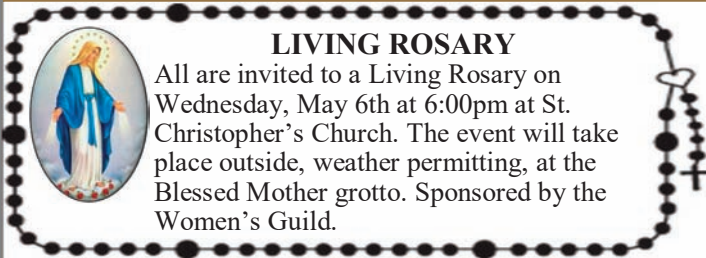

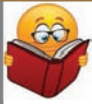

PARISH NEWS



Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

*At His feet the six-winged seraph,
Cherubim with sleepless eye,
Veil their faces to the Presence,
As with ceaseless voice they cry:
"Alleluia, alleluia, alleluia, Lord Most High!"*

Very soon, we'll have two new additions to the sanctuary at St. Theresa's: two statues of angels, kneeling in adoration. They will be placed on either side of the Tabernacle and will be a permanent fixture in the church. It is meant to be a reminder for all of us of two important realities. First, the angels in heaven never cease to praise and worship the living God. The Book of Isaiah and the Book of Revelation give accounts of visions of the angels serving and worshipping God at His heavenly throne. The very God they worship in heaven is the God they worship in His True Presence in the Tabernacle. Second, we are called to imitate the worship of the angels of Jesus's True Presence in the Most Holy Eucharist. And you and I have even more reason than the angels to fall down in worship before the mystery of the Eucharist. As St. Maximilian Kolbe once said, "If angels could be jealous of men, they would be so for one reason: Holy Communion."

Throughout Sacred Scripture, angels and statues of angels have been used to alert men and women to the Presence of God. In the Book of Exodus, when God commanded Moses to construct the Ark of the Covenant, He directed that two golden, winged cherubim would sit atop the Ark, with their wings covering the top of the Ark.

If anyone would like to memorialize one of the angels, please see me after Mass.
