**First Reading: Jeremiah 20:10-13**

Because the prophet Jeremiah foretold disaster for Jerusalem, he was denounced. But Jeremiah trusted in the Lord and overcame his persecutors.

**Second Reading: Romans 5:12-15**

Paul explains to the Romans that Adam's sin brought death to all, but Christ's gift of himself brought grace and life.

**Gospel: Matthew 10:26-33**

In authoritative and encouraging words, Jesus urges the apostles to fear nothing — only him who can destroy the soul. Telling them “every hair of your head has been counted,” he promises that “Whoever acknowledges me before men I will acknowledge before my Father in heaven.”

We remember fathers, grandfathers, and great-grandfathers who are no longer with us but who live forever in our memory and nourish us with their love. Amen.

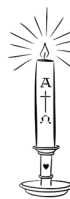

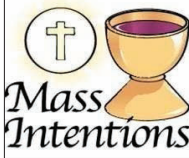

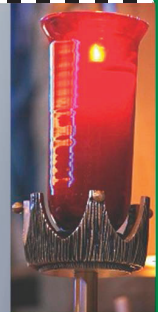

### Seminarian's Corner



Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

In last weekend's homily, Father Dufour talked about how important it is to pray for priests and seminarians. Prayer is one of the most important and potentially easiest things to do as a Christian. As a seminarian, to know that people are consistently praying for us is an incredible feeling. A priest is not a priest for himself; he is a priest for Jesus Christ, his church, and the people of God. This week I ask you to pray especially for my brother seminarians Deacon Mateusz Puzanowski of St. Joseph's Church in Central Falls and Deacon Jay Zizza of Christ the King Church in Kingston. If you do not know them, both are Transitional Deacons, are seminarians of the Diocese of Providence and will soon be ordained to the Sacred Priesthood of Jesus Christ.

The ordination is a beautiful Mass celebrated by the bishop. There are many parts to an ordination that have special significance. Before a man is ordained a deacon or a priest, he will lay prostrate on the cathedral floor. This is one of the greatest things to witness. At this moment, the men to be ordained are literally laying down their life for God; they are giving everything, their whole being to God's will. Shortly after this, those to be ordained will kneel before the bishop as he places his hands on their heads. It is at this very moment in the Mass that the men become deacons or priests.

I wish to extend an invite to anyone who may have never witnessed an ordination before to consider attending the ordination Mass of Deacons Puzanowski and Zizza as Bishop Lewandowski will ordain them to the Sacred order of the Priesthood on **Saturday, June 27, 2026, at 10:00AM at the Cathedral of Saints Peter and Paul in Providence (30 Fenner Street).**

Please keep them in your prayers as they prepare for this joyous day in our Diocese! Have a great week, and please know of my prayers for you!
