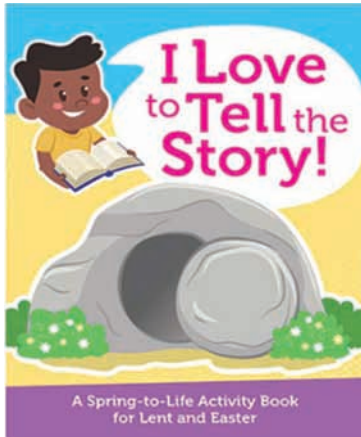

I Love to Tell the Story!

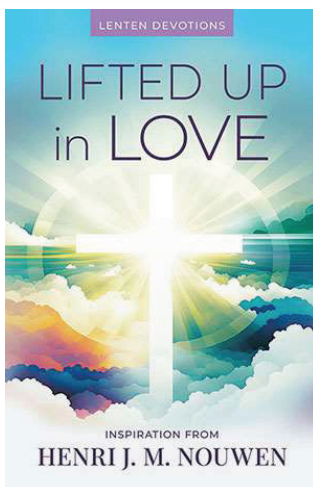
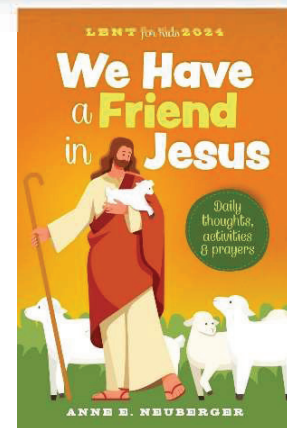

To the parishioners of OLP

I start this letter by giving thanks and praise to God, and invite you to join me in doing the same. We are truly blessed, not only for the graces and blessings that we receive on a daily basis, but for where we live and what we are able to do.

As you can see in the adjacent financial statement for the fiscal year of July 1, 2022, to June 30, 2023, through God's blessings and your generosity, we were able to not only run the parish but also take care of so many renovation and improvement projects. To name a few:

We updated the entire internet system of the rectory and made it more secure; we invested in the redesign of our parish's website (to go live very, very soon); upgraded the property's entire ground electrical grid, changing it completely to an LED system, and at the same time made provisions that it could sustain the Christmas tree memorial garden; bought all the supplies needed to create the Christmas tree memorial garden; continue with the beautification of our grounds and put into place a drip watering system to keep the gardens flourishing; updated our music ministry's sound system; and bought a new freezer for the Parish Hall. We also invested in our school by painting all the hallways and staircases; bought new furniture for different classrooms and the principal's office, as well as creating a teacher's lounge; the dirty and stained carpets were removed from every single classroom and replaced with new flooring, as well as new flooring in the hallways and entryways; the school's electrical grid was also adjusted, air conditioners were purchased for each classroom, a white picket fence was put around the existing playground, and two other fenced-in areas were created for outdoor classroom opportunities as well as more play areas. WOW!!!

All of this achieved, *100 percent*, through our Sunday offertory, as well as other restricted and non-restricted donations, and *without one single cent* coming out of our saving accounts.

Again, thank you for your generosity, your contributions and your assistance, and at the same time praise be to God for giving us the ability to have done all of the above, plus so much more that is not even mentioned in this letter. Without God we can do nothing; *praise be to God.*

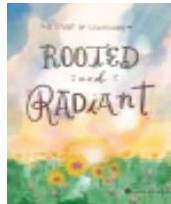
