Saint Relics at OLP!



St. Frances Xavier Cabrini

Born on July 15, 1850 in Italy
Died on December 22, 1917 in Chicago
Feast Day: November 13
Patron Saint of Immigrants

Francesca Cabrini was born to a poor farming family near Milan, Italy. She

was given religious and domestic instruction by her sister at an early age, and earned her teaching diploma at the age of 18. Applying to a convent, she was turned down for poor health. Francesca took domestic and teaching jobs until the local pastor asked her to reform a badly- run orphanage. After succeeding, the bishop asked her to found a group of missionary nuns, and she became known as Mother Frances Xavier Cabrini of the Missionary Sisters.

Over the years, Mother Cabrini founded many orphanages, schools, and hospitals, usually financed by begging, donations and hard work. At first these were in Italy, until the Pope Leo XIII asked her to take her order west to New York to serve the many poor Italian immigrants that had fled to New York City; she established schools and orphanages despites tremendous odds.

It didn't take long for requests to pour in from all over the world. She traveled to Europe, Central and South America, as well as throughout the United States. She established 67 institutions: schools, hospitals, and orphanages during her 24 trans-Atlantic voyages.
