## Fifth Sunday of Easter

Acts 14:21-27 | Rev 21:1-5a | Jn 13:31-33a, 34-35

### **GROW** AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

I'm an expressive one when it comes to sharing my opinions: I absolutely LOVE these new shoes! I LOVE, LOVE, LOVE this lemon meringue pie! All good. My friends and family are mildly pleased that I am content with my wardrobe and my diet. But in today's Gospel, Jesus gives us the great commandment, combining the two commandments - to love God and to love neighbor - into one: "Love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another." But what does it really mean to *love*? Saint Paul says it is to be patient, kind, and to rejoice with the truth; it is not being jealous, pompous, rude, or quick-tempered. (1 Cor 13: 4-6) Saint Thomas Aquinas says that "to love is to will the good of another." The love we show is the very essence of what it means to be Christian. "*This* (italics added) is how all will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."

### **GO** EVANGELIZE

#### PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

In today's reading from Acts, Paul, and Barnabas return from their travels to various Christian communities. They have shared the Good News, making disciples in each place and building up the Church. Yet when they return, they do not gloat or boast of their accomplishments. Rather, they "reported what God had done with them and how he had opened the door of faith to the Gentiles." Sometimes in our strivings - to be better friends or parents, better Christians, better at sharing our faith - we can become discouraged when we fall short. Paul, arguably the best evangelist ever, reminds us that God works through us, not the other way around. We are to persevere, placing our trust in God. Through him we are able to love as he does, and help others come to know that same love.

**ACTIONS** Spring is upon us! Plant something and watch it grow. Just as the sun and water nurture a garden, God nurtures and helps us grow through the Holy Spirit and the people around us. How can we in turn share that love with others?

**Invitation to Participate in the Worldwide Synod at the request of the Holy Father and our Bishop Sweeney.**

*Synod is an ancient and venerable word in the Tradition of the Church.*

Synodality denotes the particular style that qualifies the life and mission of the Church, expressing her nature as the People of God journeying together and gathering in assembly, summoned by the Lord Jesus in the power of the Holy Spirit to proclaim the Gospel. Synodality ought to be expressed in the Church's ordinary way of living and working.

In this sense, synodality enables the entire People of God to walk forward together, listening to the Holy Spirit and the Word of God, to participate in the mission of the Church in the communion that Christ establishes between us. Ultimately, this path of walking together is the most effective way of manifesting and putting into practice the nature of the Church as the pilgrim and missionary People of God.

The entire People of God shares a common dignity and vocation through Baptism. All of us are called in virtue of our Baptism to be active participants in the life of the Church. We are all invited to listen to one another in order to hear the promptings of the Holy Spirit, who comes to guide our human efforts, breathing life and vitality into the Church and leading us into deeper communion for our mission in the world. As the Church embarks on this synodal journey, we must strive to ground ourselves in experiences of authentic listening and discernment on the path of becoming the Church that God calls us to be.

**The Church Wants to Hear From You - How To Participate**

The feedback received from the following opportunities will be compiled in an overall synthesis at the Diocesan level. The synthesis that each Diocese will elaborate at the end of this work of listening and discernment will constitute its concrete contribution to the journey of the whole People of God by being incorporated into the General Synod led by the Holy Father in conjunction with the bishops of the world. It will also serve as a helpful document for identifying the next steps in the journey of our Diocese on the path of synodality.

**PRAYER PARTICIPATION**

The prayer being used for the Synod and its preparation is the prayer evoked by Bishops for centuries and before every session of the Second Vatican Council (1962-5).

**We stand before you, Holy Spirit, conscious of our sinfulness, but aware that we gather in your name.**

**Come to us, remain with us, and enlighten our hearts.**

**Give us light and strength to know your will, to make it our own, and to live it in our lives.**

**Guide us by your wisdom, support us by your power, for you are God, sharing the glory of Father and Son.**

**You desire justice for all: enable us to uphold the rights of others; do not allow us to be misled by ignorance or corrupted by fear or favor.**

**Unite us to yourself in the bond of love and keep us faithful to all that is true.**

**As we gather in your name may we temper justice with love, so that all our decisions may be pleasing to you, and earn the reward promised to good and faithful servants.**

**You live and reign with the Father and the Son, God, forever and ever.**

**Our Church Hearing Aid** which helps many parishioners with impaired hearing, broke down. Unfortunately, the company which produced our former system (installed over a decade ago) discontinued support for the parts. It forces our church to upgrade to a new system. The cost of the new system is estimated at \$9000. Last week we had a special collection in the church; however, you are still welcome to participate in this campaign online! So far we've collected **\$2612.00**

**What is Assisted Listening?**

A personal assisted listening system allows listeners to use a personal audio device to listen to the mix from a sound reinforcement system. This can be used by members of the congregation that are hard of hearing, require hearing aid technology, or simply want more control over the volume level of the sound at their ears. Hearing assist systems typically consist of a wireless transmitter that connects to a mixing console or digital signal processor and wireless receivers that pick up the signal. The user can then connect to the personal receiver with personal headphones, earbuds, or inductive neck loops that are compatible with telecoil-equipped hearing aids.

**ANNOUNCEMENT REGARDING THE SOLEMNITY OF THE ASCENSION**

Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord Jesus will be celebrated in all the Latin-rite dioceses of New Jersey on Sunday, May 29, 2022, replacing the liturgical celebration and readings of the Seventh Sunday of Easter. This will also include the celebration of the Liturgy of the Hours. Thursday, May 26, 2022, will be Thursday of the Sixth Week of Easter (as well as the Memorial of St. Philip Neri, Priest). In our own diocese, this will mean that the newly ordained priests will celebrate their First Masses of Thanksgiving on the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord, a special gift for the newly ordained and all of those who will rejoice with them.

**HSPT PREPARATION COURSE**

at Immaculate Heart of Mary School

July 11 – July 20 (Weekdays from 9:00 am – 11:15 am)

This is an opportunity for HMC students and students from other area schools who are taking the High School Placement Test (HSPT) on November 11, 2022, required for entrance into the Catholic high schools in the Archdioceses of Manhattan, Newark and Paterson, to prepare for the exam. The course provides an intensive review of mathematics, reading, language arts skills, instruction in quantitative and verbal reasoning, and general test-taking strategies. In addition, a full-length practice test will be administered after the first week of the course. The practice test will be scored and feedback will be provided to each student.

The course will be taught by Mr. Joseph Kievit, Chairman of the Mathematics Department and a faculty member at St. Joseph Regional High School, Montvale, NJ. Mr. Kievit teaches the SAT and ACT prep courses in SR and has over twenty years of experience in preparing middle school and high school students for standardized tests in mathematics, reading, and language arts. He has taught the HSPT course at HMC for the past eight years. Mr. Kievit was previously a Center Director with Kaplan Test Prep and Admissions.

The fee for the program is \$395 per student and covers all course materials.

The registration deadline is Tuesday, July 5, 2022
