### GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE


If the multiplication of the loaves sounds oh so familiar ... it's because it is! It's the only miracle story found in all four Gospels, and for good reason. Jesus multiplies the meager offering of a boy with five barley loaves and two fish and feeds a large crowd with baskets left over. The story is symbolic of the food that is readily available through Jesus in the Eucharist. The crowd in the Gospel that had been following Jesus was tired, worn out, and hungry. Don't we all feel discouraged now and then? When we do, Jesus makes himself available to us in the Eucharist; he provides daily food that nourishes and sustains. When we eat this life-giving bread, we are strengthened and fortified, as was the crowd in the Gospel, as we heard: "They had more than they could eat."

### GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Trusting in the bounty of God can be a challenging thing. Think about Philip in today's Gospel - looking out over the massive crowd gathered, he thought, "there's no way we'll be able to feed all of these people." And he was right! He couldn't, and we cannot. But the Lord can. And if we are to "live in a manner worthy of the call [we] have received," we must strive to live like the Apostles with complete trust in Jesus, and not rely on our own notions of what's possible and what's not. The miracle here was not that everybody was hiding fish and bread and they shared it. No, the Gospel is clear that Jesus takes what little we can offer and multiples it beyond our wildest imagination. That's the beauty of Gospel readings like this. Ordinary people are following Jesus, maybe curious about his message, maybe they know someone healed by him and want to see if he's for real. He teaches, they listen, and then something amazing happens. Let us always remember that no effort is too small for God - no kindness too ordinary. He magnifies the good we do. All we need to do is trust in his bounty, and freely give to him what we have.

**SERVE** Let's make an effort this week to try and emulate the boy in today's Gospel. Give what we have over to Jesus and say, "I trust you to make something out of this." Small acts of kindness, showing gratitude, or sharing our blessings can lead to bigger things than we think possible. We will never know the echoes of the good that we do, as it ripples out and touches other lives, but we can trust that in his love for us, God will use our good deeds for tremendous ends.



### LIVING IN GOD'S PRESENCE

In the book, Praying With Ignatius of Loyola by Jacqueline S. Bergen and Marie Scwhan (The Word Among Us Press 1991) we are led to experience God through prayer practices inspired by Ignatian beliefs and techniques. The following are adapted excerpts from this work (pp 106-112):

Living in God's Presence

Ignatius affirmed all of creation, seeing in all things the presence of God. Opening Prayer: Gracious God, your presence permeates all of creation, which is alive with your love. You smile in the hearts of your children. Open our eyes to see your brightness everywhere and always.

### About Ignatius

Ignatius experienced God's presence by the river Cardover, in study, all celebrating the liturgy, and service to poor people, and conversations, at meals – everywhere. The sense of God's presence consoled and supported him. Simple awareness of God's presence becomes a prayer, like the comfortable communication of care experienced in the silence between two friends. The spirit of Ignatius's keen sense of God's presence in all of life can be seen in the poetry of Jesuit Gerard Manley Hopkins' "God's Grandeur"



God's Grandeur

The world is charged with the grandeur of God.

It will flameout, like shining from shook foil; It gathers to a greatness, like the ooze of oil Crushed. Why do men then now not wreck his rod?

Generations have trod, have trod, have trod; And all is seared with trade; bleared, smeared with toil;

And wears man's smudge and shares man's smell: the soil

Is bare now, nor can foot feel, being shod.

And for all this, nature is never spent; There lives the dearest freshness deep down things;

And though the last lights off the black West went

Oh, morning, at the brown brink eastward, springs -

Because the Holy Ghost over the bent World broods with warm breast and with ah! Bright wings.

The world is "charged with the grandeur of God" if we can but see it.

For a greater appreciation of this poem, you can do an internet search for, Analysis of Hopkin's Poem God's Grandeur, which is helpful in understanding the thoughts and images conveyed in this very stylized poetic form

### Reflection Activities

· Go for a stroll on the banks of a river or stream, in a forest clearing, under a starlit sky, or to some other favorite spot in nature. Take your time. Allow yourself to see, touch, smell, hear, even taste all the goodness of bounding there. Enter into your experience. And, as you feel the prompting of your spirit, respond to the Creator.

### Follow this meditation:

- 1. Remember that God is present around and within you. Invite God into conversation.
- Ask God to enlighten your understanding and appreciation of all the wonders that you have been given in creation.
   Recall that God has given you everything that is good, as a free gift. Bring to mind all the gifts that you have been given.
   Express your love and thanks to God for all the gifts by offering the following prayer by Ignatius Take, Lord, and receive...

Take, Lord, and receive all my liberty, my memory, my understanding, and my entire will, all that I have and possess. You have given all to me. To you, Lord, I return it. All is yours. Dispose of it wholly according to your will. Give me your love and your grace. That is enough for me.

· What do you find moving, touching, challenging in this prayer? Discuss it with God.







IN HIS APOSTOLIC EXHORTATION AT THE BEGINNING OF THE NEW MILLENNIUM, POPE ST JOHN PAUL II STATED THAT "THE CHURCH OF THE THIRD MILLENNIUM WILL NEED TO ENCOURAGE ALL THE BAPTISED AND CONFIRMED TO BE AWARE OF THEIR ACTIVE RESPONSIBILITY IN THE CHURCH'S LIFE." Jesus still multiplies what we give Him today. At Mass we offer to God some bread and wine and He turns it into the Body and Blood of Jesus!


We have something to offer to Jesus too. If you offer your work, or your talents, or even your whole life to God, He will use your gifts to bring His blessings to the world.
