Gen 12:1-4a | 2 Tim 1:8b-10 | Mt 17:1-9

### GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

What struck me when I first read this passage from the Book of Genesis, in which the Lord speaks to Abraham, is God's proclamation that it is through *his will* and *his work* that the blessings and goodness of Abraham's future will come about. It is not a vague statement, in which the subject is omitted. God clearly says, "I will make your name great." Abraham was a faithful servant of God and sought to obey God's will, but that is not what made his name memorable. It is due to God's will and generosity that Abraham's blessings came about. I sometimes struggle with giving up credit for the good things in my life. I want to believe that *my work*, *my talents*, and *my dedication* have brought about these good things. But the reality is that all of who I am and the skills that I have is a gift. I was created by God and formed by others to hone certain dispositions and talents that have led to my accomplishments. When we come to realize that all we have is a gift, we are able to offer our lives back to be transfigured and glorified by God, who creates and gives all things.

### GO EVANGELIZE

#### PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Many scholars identify this moment of the Transfiguration as the climax of the narrative arc of the Gospels, after which Christ's actions lead to his suffering and death. In his passion, Christ demonstrates the ultimate submission to the will of God, taking on the weight of human sin in order to redeem us. In this moment of Transfiguration on the mountain, we glimpse the beauty of the glorification that will result from this perfect obedience to God's will. We, too, are called to surrender ourselves fully to God. Following Jesus' model of humble submission to the Father's will does not involve false humility, in which we are self-deprecating or overly critical of ourselves. Instead, we are called to acknowledge and celebrate our gifts and accomplishments, while also recognizing that who we are and the gifts that we have come from our generous and loving God.

### REFLECT

Reflect on the gifts and talents you have been given, as well as the accomplishments that have come about because of these gifts. Take a moment to thank God for all that he has given to you, and ask him to reveal how you can be a witness to his goodness through the prudent use and celebration of these gifts.



# From the Pastor's Desk

## Second Sunday of Lent



Lent can feel like a long walk. We start strong, then we hit the middle of a week and wonder, "Am I really changing, or just trying harder?"

Today's readings answer that with a quiet, steady truth: God changes us by calling us forward, then letting us see a glimpse of where we're going.

In the first reading, Abram is told something that would make most of us stall: Leave what you know. Go where I will show you. He is not given a map. He is given a promise, and a direction. And Abram goes.

That's faith at its most practical. Not a feeling. Not a perfect plan. A decision to take the next step with God. Then the Gospel gives us the Transfiguration. Jesus takes Peter, James, and John up the mountain. They see glory they cannot explain. They hear the Father's voice: "This is my beloved Son... listen to him."

It's not just a "wow" moment. It's mercy. Jesus knows the cross is coming, and he strengthens his friends before the hard days arrive. God does that with us too.

Sometimes it's in prayer. Sometimes it's a line from Scripture that stays with you all day. Sometimes it's a surprising peace in the middle of stress. A glimpse of light, so you can keep walking.

And notice what happens next: they come down the mountain. Lent is not about staying in spiritual "high places." It's about bringing what you've seen into ordinary life: your tone at home, your patience in traffic, your honesty at work, your ability to forgive, your willingness to begin again.

This week, the Church also remembers witnesses who lived that "next step" faith: St. Katharine Drexel (March 3), St. Casimir (March 4), and Ss. Perpetua and Felicity (March 7). Different lives, same courage: trust God enough to move when he calls.

So here is a simple Lenten goal for the week: Listen to Jesus, then take one concrete step. Not ten. One. God can do a lot with one faithful step.

### Reflection Questions for the Week

- Where is God asking me to "go forth" right now, even without having every detail?
- What helps me listen to Jesus in a real way: silence, Scripture, adoration, a specific daily routine?
- When have I experienced a "glimpse of light" that strengthened me for a difficult season?
- What is one specific habit I can bring down the mountain this week: kinder speech, less complaining, more prayer, quicker forgiveness?
- If I truly believed God is leading me somewhere good, what would I do differently today?

### Prayer for the Week


Lord Jesus,  
take me up the mountain with you. Let me hear your voice above the noise and trust you more than my worries. Give me courage to take the next step, even when I cannot see the whole path. And when I come down into ordinary life, help me carry your light with humility and joy. Amen.



# Jesus Shows His Glory



In today's Gospel reading Jesus took three of His apostles up a mountain and gave them a vision of His true glory. He shone as bright as the sun- so bright they could hardly look at Him. But did you know that what they saw was only a tiny bit of the true glory of God?

It was so beautiful that Peter wanted Him to stay that way. He offered to build tents for Jesus and Moses and Elijah, who appeared with Him. But the joy of that moment wasn't meant to last forever. It was just a little taste of Heaven.

Jesus gave this experience to the three apostles just a little while before He went to Jerusalem to suffer and die on the cross. He knew that they would be terrified and very sad when He died so He gave them a preview of the glory He would go back to after He rose from the dead. That way they knew they had a reason to hope even when He was killed.

Sometimes we have awful things to suffer through too. Maybe a friend will move away or one of our grandparents will die. But we never have to give up hope because we know that eventually everyone who loves Jesus will live in total happiness in Heaven.


