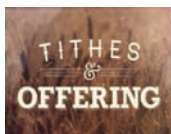
Dear God,

DEDICATION OF A MASS

Offering a Mass intention is one of the most ancient and beautiful ways Catholics pray for one another. At every Mass, the Church unites the faithful - living and departed - to the one sacrifice of Christ, making it a uniquely powerful moment to lift up a loved one, a special need, or a heartfelt thanksgiving. Our parish offers several intention schedules, from a single Mass to extended series of consecutive celebrations, so you can find the form of prayer that fits your intention.

DIFFERENT TYPES OF MASS INTENTIONS

Singular Mass - \$20

One Mass offered for a deceased person, a special need or occasion, or in thanksgiving. We are honored to unite your intention to the prayer of the Church.

Novena Mass Series - \$130

Nine Masses celebrated on consecutive days. The novena is one of the Church's most beloved devotional forms, rooted in the nine days the Apostles spent in prayer between the Ascension and Pentecost. This series is a beautiful way to sustain a particular intention over time.

Gregorian Mass Series - \$450

Thirty Masses celebrated on consecutive days, offered exclusively for one deceased person. Because of the care required to arrange this series, we ask for your patience as we confirm available dates. Please contact the parish office to discuss scheduling.

GREGORIAN MASS SERIES

Gregorian Masses are thirty Holy Masses offered on consecutive days for a single soul, traditionally begun as soon as possible after death. The practice rests on the Church's belief that few souls pass immediately into heaven, and that Christ's sacrifice, made present at every Mass, can continually perfect a departing soul in grace until it enters fully into union with God.

The custom takes its name from Saint Gregory the Great (Pope, 590-604), who records in his Dialogues that he had thirty consecutive Masses offered for a monk named Justus. At the conclusion of the thirtieth Mass, Justus appeared to a fellow monk and announced he had been delivered from Purgatory.

The Cross That Leads to *Life*

“Whoever wishes to come after me
must deny himself, take up his cross,
and follow me.”

— MATTHEW 16:24



This Sunday, Peter learns that following Jesus is not only about glory, certainty, and inspiring moments. Just last Sunday, Peter confessed beautifully, “You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.” Now, when Jesus begins to speak about suffering, rejection, death, and resurrection, Peter resists. He takes Jesus aside and says, “God forbid, Lord!”

Peter loves Jesus, but he does not yet understand the way of Jesus.

That is often true for us too. We want faith to bring peace, strength, and comfort, and it does. But sometimes we forget that faith also asks for surrender, sacrifice, and trust when the road is hard. Jesus does not hide this from His disciples. He says clearly, “Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me.”

Those words can sound heavy. But Jesus is not asking us to love suffering for its own sake. He is teaching us that real love always carries a cross. Parents know this. Caregivers know this. Married couples know this. Priests, teachers, nurses, volunteers, and anyone who has stayed faithful through difficulty knows this. Love asks something of us. It stretches us beyond convenience. It teaches us to give when we would rather hold back.

Jeremiah understands this struggle. In the first reading, he feels the cost of speaking God's word. He is mocked, tired, and tempted to stay silent. Yet he says that God's word becomes like fire burning in his heart. He cannot hold it in. Faith is not always comfortable, but it becomes a fire within us. It keeps calling us back to what is true.

St. Paul gives us the practical shape of discipleship:

“Offer your bodies as a living sacrifice.” That means our faith is not limited to Sunday words or private thoughts. It touches our daily lives: how we speak, forgive, serve, work, spend, listen, and respond when we are frustrated. Paul also tells us not to conform ourselves to this age, but to be transformed by the renewal of our minds. In other words, do not let the world teach you what life is worth. Let Christ teach you.

The Gospel asks a direct question: What are we gaining, and what are we losing? Jesus says, “What profit would there be for one to gain the whole world and forfeit his life?” It is possible to win arguments and lose peace. To gain approval and lose integrity. To stay comfortable and lose courage. To protect our plans and miss God's will.

The cross is not easy, but it is not empty. Jesus speaks of suffering, but He also speaks of resurrection. The cross is the place where love becomes visible, where mercy becomes concrete, and where God brings life from what looks like loss.

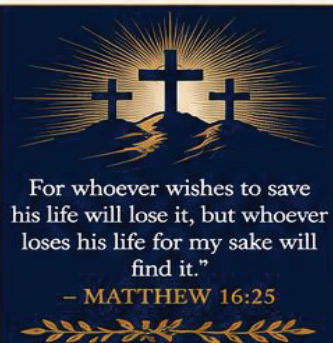
This week, ask the Lord to show you the cross you are being called to carry with Him. It may be patience with someone difficult. It may be forgiveness. It may be honesty. It may be service that no one notices. It may be letting go of control. It may be returning to prayer when you feel dry or discouraged. Do not carry it alone. Bring it to Christ. The cross carried with Him is never the end of the story.

The way of Jesus is demanding, but it leads to life.



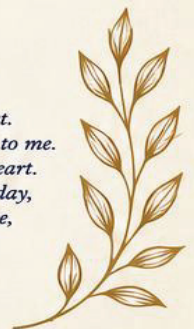
Reflection Questions

Twenty-second Sunday in Ordinary Time

Jer 20:7-9 | Rom 12:1-2 | Mt 16:21-27

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Peter, understandably, responded to Christ's foreshadowing of his death with shock and horror – insisting that Jesus would not suffer and die. But Christ's words to his disciples taught them all to respond with humble obedience, trusting in the mission of God without fully understanding it. And Jeremiah in the first reading felt that God had “duped” him. Perhaps the message here is to expect the unexpected when taking on a life of holiness. In my own vocations of marriage, motherhood, and teaching, I regularly encounter challenges and surprises. As disciples, when we discern the will of God in our lives and choose to live according to his will, we do so not because we know all that it will entail, but because we know and trust the One who calls us. We are not promised an easy life, but we are promised abundant life. God calls us to a life of holiness because he knows that is what will bring us fulfillment and peace.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

In the process of discernment, we consider our gifts and talents, humbly reflect upon what is needed to build the kingdom of God, and listen carefully in prayer to the voice of God. We have the immense gifts of Sacred Tradition and Scripture to facilitate the “renewal of [the] mind” (Rom 12:2) as we allow our minds and hearts to be transformed by God's will. And in humble obedience, we must be honest with ourselves about whether we are fully open to God's call, even when it is contrary to our plans. When we believe with our entire being that we are living according to God's will, we will not be able to remain quiet or live in a mediocre way. Just as Jeremiah was unable to keep himself from speaking on the Lord's behalf, the Good News of Christ will come pouring forth from our being in everything that we do. And in this outpouring of God's love, we will give others the opportunity to encounter Christ through us.

REFLECT

Spend some time this week considering the vocation to which you are being called. Reflect upon how you can grow in trust of God to depend upon his care and guidance as you serve according to his will. Although our specific call may be challenging and may seem overwhelming, we can trust in the promise that following God's will leads to a life of joy and peace.
