The Baptism of the Lord January 13, 2019



My dear parishioners, as I write this article on January 8th, I am now on my 12th day at Kessler Institute. I have therapy every morning from 9:00am – 2:00pm with a little break for lunch. Needless to say by 2:00pm I'm exhausted. I have developed a little routine. After a little sleep I find time to check my emails and texts and keep in touch with the office.

I'm grateful to a group of Extraordinary Ministers who bring me Holy Communion every day.

As you can imagine, I'm not able for too many visitors because I really need to get myself back on track but I deeply appreciate the Mass intentions, the prayers and the cards. The staff here at Kessler work very hard. They push me to the limit and that's why I chose Kessler. My hope and prayer is that I get home in a couple of weeks and I hope to celebrate Mass from my trusty wheelchair. My deepest gratitude to you, my parish family, for all the love and concern you have given to me these past weeks. To Fr. Matthew, who rumor has it, is now celebrating the 7:30am Sunday Mass and has taken to enjoying the morning!!! Thanks to my wonderful staff who keeps the parish running smoothly. I'm blessed that I can recuperate because I know the parish is in a good place and all the ministries are being taken well care of. Be assured of my prayers during this time.

This weekend we celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. Our Gospel reading this weekend reminds us of Jesus being baptized in the Jordan River by His cousin John. John the Baptist was shocked and humbled when Jesus asked him to baptize Him. John understood that Jesus didn't need Baptism because He knew Jesus was God. From that time on all men, women, boys, girls and babies are immersed into the Christian faith through the Sacrament of Baptism. This weekend let us give thanks to God for our parents and godparents who invited the priest to baptize us. Let us thank God for being baptized and reflect upon our own willingness to serve God as practicing Catholics. I'm preparing two adults for Baptism on Holy Saturday and one former Protestant for entry into the Catholic Church. The cold crisp nights give us a magnificent view of the moon and the stars. We get a sense of the incredible universe God has made for us. As I look to the night sky, especially in winter, I enjoy my night walk and feel the immensity of God's love. This love is given especially to us who are human beings made in His image and likeness. Early Childhood Center News

During Cc week, we learned about how different animals behave and survive in the cold. We discovered that some animals **hibernate** in the winter while others adapt and not only survive, but **thrive** in the cold! Our STEM project involved the discovery of penguin chicks and how they change as they grow from **downy** covered chicks to **waterproof** feathered adults. Our experiment showed us how adult penguins stay warm in cold temperatures and icy waters and how the changes they undergo enable them to go from dependent chicks to independent swimmers and hunters “flying” through the frigid water. **Experiment:**

1. We covered our penguin chick template with soft, thick, fluffy cotton balls to simulate penguin chicks’ downy feathers.
2. We covered our adult penguin template with waxy crayon to simulate the adult penguins’ waterproof feathers.
3. We sprayed each of our penguins with colored water and observed what happened.

We discovered that the colored water was **absorbed** by the cotton and made the penguin chicks **soggy** and **heavy**. We also discovered that the water was **repelled** by the waxy crayon and **beaded** and rolled off the adult penguins. This experiment shows why penguin chicks can’t swim until they **molt** and their adult feathers grow in!
