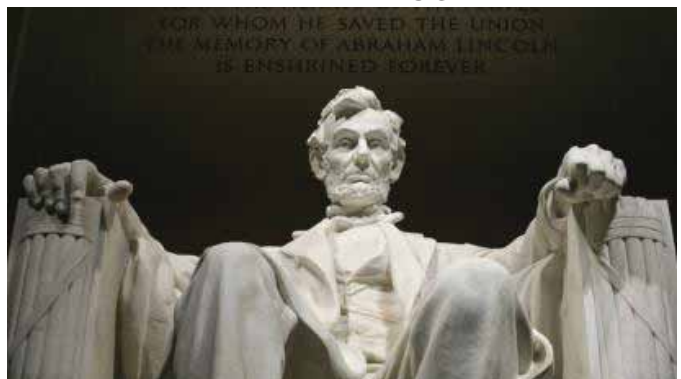

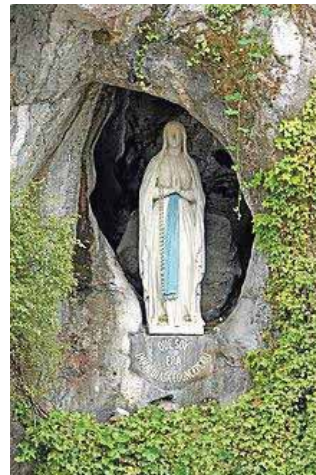
FOOD PANTRY

Miss Casey's class has been learning about winter animals and winter wonderlands. Students watched a Scholastic video about the arctic and saw how polar bears, snow hares, and foxes lived. We even learned how they stay warm compared to us. Our S.T.E.M unit this month focused on winter, too. Students had to work together to build a tower out of plastic cups and figure out a way for it to stay standing. This uses the children's critical thinking skills, a very important part of our curriculum. When the tower was built, they got to throw "snowballs" at the tower to knock it down. The Early Childhood Center celebrated Catholic Schools Week! Catholic Schools Week is a national celebration of Catholic education and an opportunity to recognize the importance, the value, and the contributions of Catholic education to the Church and the world.

Everyone completed their own shape book to take home and share with their families. To reinforce these concepts, students got to play a fun game of color/shape bingo as well as make play-doh shapes.
