




Registration—Call or email the parish to register

Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord

We listen to Mary, the Apostle to the Apostles, the first eyewitness of the resurrection, as she preaches to us in the Easter sequence. She says, "Yes, Christ, my hope, has arisen." And we respond, "Christ indeed from death is risen, our new life obtaining. Have mercy, Victor King, ever reigning!"

Jesus Christ is "wonderful in our eyes" because "the stone which the builders rejected has become the cornerstone." We know that "by the Lord has this been done" (Psalm 118:22 – 24). God wills the inclusion of rejected and despised people, and the truth of our shared baptismal identity and dignity compels us never to call anyone profane or unclean.

May the resurrection of Jesus Christ, "the one appointed by God as judge of the living and the dead" (Acts 10:42), clear out all the "old yeast of malice and wickedness" and give us "the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth" (1 Corinthians 5:7 – 8). Amen



Appalachia Outreach 2024

Youth Ministry/Appalachia Spotlight: Ren Lake



Hi, my name is Ren Lake. I'm a junior at Morristown High School. I love theatre (I construct sets and am a secretary on the Thespian Honor Society board), crocheting, reading, playing the violin, listening to music, hanging out with my friends, and photography. The thing is, I am not a member of St. Virgil's. I have gone to the Church of Christ the King in New Vernon my whole life, and am involved with their youth events and lectoring. I am on the retreat team there, which serves to guide kids going through the Confirmation process. I lead peer discussions, lead and participate in prayer opportunities, and give religious talks based on my experiences and faith. We do retreats, but it doesn't come close to the physical and mental challenges of the Appalachia trip. We do small retreats lasting a few days, in a building that is barely a 5-minute walk from the church. I heard about this retreat from some friends who have been on it and all

about the wonderful things people have done to help those in need in the community of Harlan. I immediately wanted to directly help these people in need. The trip being a 9-day service trip, 11 hours away, doing manual labor to serve the community members is so unique and remarkable to me. I have heard so many stories about the community members, the work, and the environment of the retreat off-site, and this retreat seems so worthwhile to me. I would love the opportunity to grow in my faith. The St. Virgil's Church and community have been so welcoming and open to me, and I want to thank everyone for that.
