





With Spring comes baseball again, so many beautiful grass fields all over America. As the saying goes, "As American as baseball and apple pie". Makes one want some apple pie, doesn't it?

Baseball was everything to me as a kid growing up in Northeastern New Jersey. I ate, drank, and slept baseball. I was always playing it, either on Little League teams, or on my grammar school and high school teams or with friends, or even by myself throwing a ball against a wall endlessly. When I graduated high school, I hung up my first baseman's glove forever—though I did at age 36 in the spring and summer play in an over 30 league to see if I could still do it. I could!

There is so much happiness over that for months, until the next baseball season. Like the good athlete, we should be working day and night to becoming better Catholics, better followers and disciples of Jesus the Christ, better than merely doing or saying the right thing 3 out of 10 times. We do it for our individual salvation, but also for the good of our brothers and sisters around us and in thanksgiving to our Creator and Redeemer and Sanctifier who, if we allow His will to operate without interference from our own will, bats 1.000 every time!




