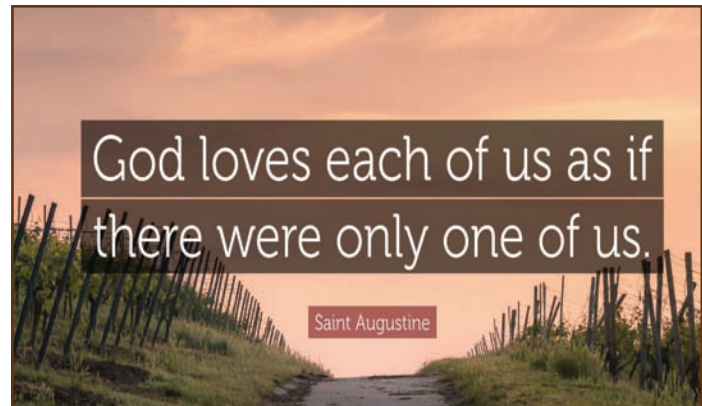

## From the Pastor's Desk



Hello everyone,

When I was a child my sisters and I watched a lot of cartoons. My first favorite was Mighty Mouse. Later, we loved Bugs Bunny, the Road Runner, Yogi Bear and his sidekick BooBoo. We would hear from other kids that their parents wouldn't let them watch cartoons, or the 3 stooges, because they were afraid of the negative repercussions. My parents for the most part did not seem to mind as long as we did not spend too much time in front of the TV. "Go outside and play!" was a very familiar command. I don't think children get that command anymore! Now many parents are afraid of the negative effects of the phone and social media on their kids.

Many of those cartoons we watched ended with the popular Porky Pig stuttering a "That's all Folks!" Now of course that stuttering would not be allowed. The message was a good one though—that's all, folks. Now do something new because this is over.

That is a good message for us. The Lord wants us to be holy. To be holy, we must live in the here and now, be fully present to God's direction and to our fellow human beings in front of us now. Yet so much of our brain time can be spent dwelling on the past. And the past is over and done with!

And so we may be carrying hurts and injustices from the past on our shoulders days, weeks, even years later! As adults, we may go over in our minds again and again and again what happened to us in our childhood. We may even ridicule others, even therapists, who tell us to "let it go—move on". We say, I can't, it was too traumatic, too unjust, I just can't forgive them or him or her.

Guess what, people? The Lord wants us to be compassionate and merciful even to those horrible people who did or said such horrible things to us. God wants us to forgive them and let it go. God wants us to be holy.

We all have scars and hurts from things that have happened in our past. But we trust God takes care of things. We put it at His feet and trustingly move on. We are certainly not, as we hear in our Gospel this weekend, sheep without a shepherd. We have asked God to heal us and He has with His grace upon us. We walk in the light now, there is no darkness. We fear no evil, none from the past, none now, and none that may come to us in the future, for God is with us.

God's healing comes and we embrace it with love for without cost we have received. Now, fully alive in Christ, without cost we are to give, as Jesus reminds us this weekend.

## **A FRESH PERSPECTIVE ON THE SUNDAY READINGS**

His Word today, by Rev. William J. Reilly

Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

**“At the sight of the crowd, Jesus’ heart was moved with pity for them because they were troubled and abandoned, like sheep without a shepherd. Then he said to his disciples, ‘The harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest.’”**

Jesus not only spent time among the people, but He also observed what was happening to them. He responded. Notice what motivated His response, pity and compassion. It is interesting to note to remedy the situation, He suggested that the disciples act in their behalf, we might say ‘all hands -on deck.’ The Lord is serious and asks if we are.

As we observe the lack of priestly and diaconal, or religious vocations to serve, it is time we find committed baptized to use their gifts for the Lord. How many are being called, but are deaf or preoccupied with themselves, not their salvation. While many people are trying to advance in their chosen profession, if the Lord has a meaning in their lives, there should be time and there are possibilities to make great contributions to the cause. We see lay missionaries giving a year or two for service, our parish communities look for catechists, home visitors, liturgical ministers even for people to clean or dust the church. What would it be like if only one half of those who are active were unable to continue to serve?

It is the Lord asking us to ask, or even better, to act.

## **CALLING ALL PARISHIONERS**

Our Lady of Fatima. Our Lady of Lourdes. Our Lady of Champion. *Our Lady of Champion?* Yes! On October 9, 1859, the third of three Marian apparitions which appeared to twenty-eight year old Adele Brice (or Brise) took place in Champion, Wisconsin. Those apparitions are noteworthy because, *as of 2010 when they were first approved, continuing until today, they represent the first and only Church-approved appearances of Our Lady in our country’s history.*

What did Our Blessed Mother come to Champion, Wisconsin to ask of Adele? Here are Our Lady’s words, as Adele heard and remembered them: **“Gather the children in this wild country and teach them what they should know for salvation.”** Elaborating in response to Adele’s follow-up query about *what* she should teach them, Our Blessed Mother said, **“Teach them their catechism, how to sign themselves with the sign of the Cross, and how to approach the sacraments; that is what I wish you to do. Go and fear nothing, I will help you.”**

Lourdes. Fatima. Champion. Because we are members of one family in God, every one of Our Lady’s apparition messages has global importance. At the same time, her messages have particular local relevance, too. Likewise, because Our Lady’s messages are timely and timeless, although we American Catholics are living more than one hundred sixty years after Mother Mary made her request of Adele, we might consider if her words still hold relevance today, and what her Son would ask of *us* in our present circumstances to do to fulfill His Mother’s directive, as did Adele, in her vocation as a religious Sister and teacher of youngsters.

During the recent Eucharistic Revival, Adele’s cause for canonization moved forward, and the National Shrine of Our Lady of Champion, which marks the apparition site, was one of the destinations for the USA nationwide pilgrimage. In recognition of Our Blessed Mother’s second and third apparitions, which took place on October 9, that date has been chosen as the feast of Our Lady of Champion. Perhaps from now on we might make a point of celebrating that Marian feast—even though we are not visionaries, for (*paraphrasing her Son*), as Our Blessed Mother said about Adele’s companions who did not see Our Lady’s beautiful apparition either: **“Blessed are they that believe without seeing”** (cf Jn 20:29).

When you go before the Eucharistic Lord this week, with the assistance of Mother Mary’s Spouse, the Holy Spirit, you might ponder Our Lady of Champion’s request, making a commitment as a god/parent, grandparent, and neighbor to do your part to continue Adele Brice’s work regarding the Faith education of the youth of this (*still “wild” in many ways*) country. Why not commit to putting a smile on Our Lady of Champion’s beautiful face? As best you can, in whatever ways you can, why not serve as a Faith coach and champion to the American youth whom the Lord sends into your life!

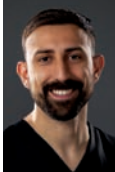
